Lots of sunshine and southerly winds will help us warm up today, though a cold front will reach the area by 6pm. This cold front will be weak, with the only real impact being a wind shift.

Today: Sunny with a high near 73° and SW wind 5-15 mph becoming NW in the afternoon.

Tonight: A low near 40° with clear skies. N-NW wind at 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny with a high near 67°. Wind will be N-NW near 5 mph

Wednesday Night: Mostly cloudy with a low near 46° and light wind from the E-SE becoming S-SW after midnight.

Thursday: Mostly sunny with a high near 75°, and S-SW wind 5-15 mph.

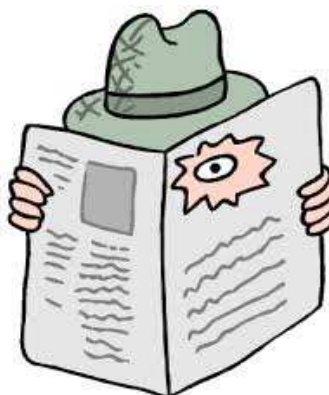
