Cyber Attacks and the Holidays

(CBS news) – The FBI said the holidays and weekends are prime time for cybercriminals to make millions on ransomware attacks.

“The last couple of years, we’ve seen an almost exponential growth in ransomware attacks,” said FBI Supervisory Agent Jonathan Holmes. “We’ve also seen exponential growth in ransom demands.”

Holmes said cybercriminals are now requesting tens of millions of dollars. “They’re the same individuals that might have been around for years that used to steal your credit card information,” said Holmes. “They now recognize instead of stealing credits, I can make way more money by just hitting a business with ransomware and demanding a large amount of money.”

According to a 2021 FBI report, from January to July, they received more than 2,000 ransomware complaints with more than \$16 million in losses, which is a 20% increase in reported losses compared to the same time in 2020. This can be prevented. Agent Holmes said “Make sure you’re educating your employees to not click on any old links, to make sure they’re not going on malicious websites,” he said.

Holmes said if you do become a victim, don’t pay the ransom. Instead, report it to the FBI right away, so they can investigate and bring the criminal to justice.

When it comes to online shopping, Holmes recommends customers do their research and make sure the website is secure. Don’t click on suspicious links or just give personal information to anyone.

The FBI said two of the most prevalent scams are non-delivery and non-payment where a buyer pays for an item but never receives it or an item is shipped but the seller never receives payment.

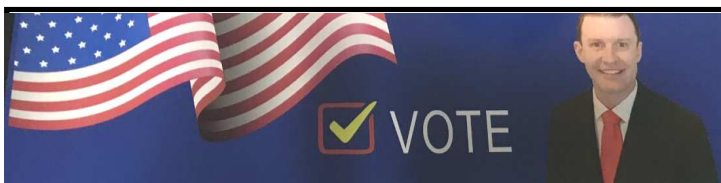
Beto to Visit Harker Heights Tomorrow

The Democratic gubernatorial candidate, Beto O'Rourke, is scheduled to visit Harker Heights, Dec. 4, according to the candidate's campaign website.

The meet-and-greet will be from 10am to 11am at the Carl Levin Park Pavilion, 400 Millers Crossing, Harker Heights, TX 76548.

The former El Paso congressman, 2018 U.S. Senate nominee and 2020 presidential contender officially announced his campaign in a video posted to YouTube on Monday, Nov. 15. In the video, O'Rourke cites the power grid failure during February's winter storm as one of the reasons he is running, stating that Texans were "abandoned by those who were elected to serve and look out for them" and that is a "symptom of a much larger problem" in Texas.

Rumors of O'Rourke's plan to run for governor of Texas have swirled for months and the clock has been ticking, with the candidate filing deadline for the March 2022 primary less than a month away. A recent poll from the University of Texas at Austin and The Texas Tribune showed Gov. Greg Abbott with a comfortable lead over O'Rourke in a potential match-up.
