## The Annual Carol of Lights Festival

in Lampasas began as a simple event, organized and engineered each year by the late Betty Ann Whitis, a beloved elementary school music teacher,

Betty Ann got the kids from her music class down to the Presbyterian Church parking lot each year in early December. From there they would each carry a candle, or sometimes a flashlight, and march eastward down 3rd Street, singing Christmas Carols as they went. The destination was always the bandstand on Courtyard Square, where the community would join them in singing the Christmas songs we all loved.

There were changes and additions each year and different ways to accomplish, but it was always about Christmas and the joy it gives each of us to sing and to enjoy our friends and family and our community.

One of the principal parts of the event has always been the lighting of the courthouse, traditionally carried out by the Lampasas Mayor and other dignitaries. After introductions and comments to a crowd of onlookers at the town Bandstand, they flip a switch that lights up the strings of lights that run overhead from the Courthouse to adjacent buildings. Lampasas' old Courthouse has seen its lights turned on every Christmas since well longer than any of us can remember. Memories of the Courthouse lights, as viewed both downtown, and from the hills well outside the town, are something Lampasas youth carry with them throughout their lives.

After the lights are turned on, there's music on the bandstand and the Flames drill team, and then attention turns to 3rd Street. There, the carolers are not the only thing that comes down the street to the square these days. It's the "Lighted Christmas Parade."

Lampasas has one of the first of such spectacles, with parade floats gaily decorated with Christmas lights – conveniently done with the recent availability of efficient battery operated LEDs.

# **TxDOT Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects**

As Texas strives to reduce the rising number of pedestrian and bicyclist fatalities, TxDOT is making available around \$250 million for its 2023 Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects.

The federal funding will go towards sidewalks, bike lanes, shared-use paths and other projects to enhance walking and biking transportation across the state.

"Making it safer and easier to walk and bike is an important part of our mission of 'Connecting You with Texas," TxDOT Transportation Commissioner Robert "Robie" Vaughn said. "I'm thrilled to see this increase in funding that'll help communities build impactful improvements for its citizens. As a jogger and cyclist myself, I know the value these enhancements can bring to help Texans get to work, run errands, and enjoy the beautiful Texas outdoors."

TxDOT will hold virtual workshops to help municipalities and organizations as they apply for this funding.

The number of pedestrians and cyclists killed on Texas roads has been rising over the past several years with pedestrian fatalities increasing by 15% and cyclist fatalities by 14% in 2021. This funding will help communities plan and build walking and biking infrastructure that could help reduce these incidents.


