The Weather The High yesterday 75°

Our region is under a large area of high pressure this morning, and though a weak cold front brought a wind shift yesterday evening, temperatures should warm to the mid 60's this afternoon, a few degrees cooler than yesterday.

Over the next 7 days a series of cold fronts will pass through the area, leading to periods of above normal temperatures followed by slightly below normal temperatures. Expect temperatures on Friday to be 10-15 degrees cooler than yesterday, with north winds making it feel blustery.

Today: Sunny with a high near 70°. Calm wind becoming E-NE at 5 mph this afternoon.

Tonight: Partly cloudy with a low near 48° and E-SE wind at 5 mph becoming S-SW after midnight.

Thursday: Mostly sunny with a high near 76°. Wind will be S at 5-15 mph.

Thursday Night: A low near 46° and mostly clear skies. Wind will be S near 10 mph becoming N-NW after midnight.

Friday: Sunny with a high temperature near 62° . Wind will be N at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 38° and N wind 5-10 mph.

Saturday: Sunny with a high near 65°. Calm winds will become light from the SE in the afternoon.
