Carol of Lights 2021

The Carol of Lights officially kicks off the Holiday Season in Lampasas today. This year's theme is "Blessings from the Heart of Texas"

The day gets going early with the farmers market from 8am-3pm on the east side of the square. 9am will find the classic cars 'Classics at the Classic' on the south side of the square until 4pm. There will be food trucks available from 10am – 8pm on the square as well. The Lampasas County museum will be open from 10am-7pm with the Christmas Tree Display contest and the Gingerbread House Contest, and a bake sale from 2-7pm. The annual Snow Queen Pageant will take place at 1pm on the bandstand, then at 5:30pm community groups will sing Christmas Carols. 6pm brings the Lampasas High School Flames program followed by the official Carol of Lights Lighting Ceremony at the bandstand. The Ajinomoto Foods Holidazzle Lighted Christmas Parade begins at 6:30pm with Robert Lu as the Grand Marshal, and the parade being announced and

broadcast on 101.9fm KACQ.

Children's activities scheduled for the day include Santa Claus in the Ajinomoto Foods lobby at 601 E. 3rd St. from 3:30-6pm. Mask required and social distancing. Mrs. Santa's house will be open at the corner of 3rd and Western in the old Manuel Hardware building. There will be storytelling by Mrs. Claus at that location at 3:30 and 4:30pm, and from 4-4:30 there will be Christmas Crafts all brought to you by the Lampasas Public Library and LAFTA.

First Texas Bank on the square will have their Cup o' Corn from 4-5:30pm.

Come and join the community for the festivities.

Nobody on the event committee is paid for their services in any manner other than the knowledge that they made a difference in the children's lives in our community.

This year the Tri-County Toy Run will be on Sunday December 5th. It will start out at the Mayborn Convention Center in Temple at 1pm and will be escorted. The destination is Hancock Park in Lampasas.

Lampasas ISD School Board to Meet

The **Lampasas ISD Board of Trustees** will meet Monday December 6th at 6pm in the school administration building at 207 W. 8th St.

The agenda includes the consent agenda which includes a budget amendment, resignation of professional personnel, revisions of local policies, policy updates, and the purchase of computer replacement devices. Also included in the agenda is the audit report for 2020-2021, a public hearing for the School First Financial rating, the election of appraisal district board, some business with 'authorizing the issuance of Lampasas ISD limited tax refunding bonds, series 2022'. Also on the agenda is a possible consultation with the attorney regarding petition for detachment and annexation.

Coronavirus Update

Statewide, on December 3rd, there were 2,005 new and 1006 probable cases, along with 2,892 in the hospital. There were 74 deaths from Covid reported as well. Locally, in the last 14 days, Lampasas has seen 33 confirmed cases according to the DSHS website, with 1 being confirmed Thursday. The state estimate is 44 active cases in Lampasas County.

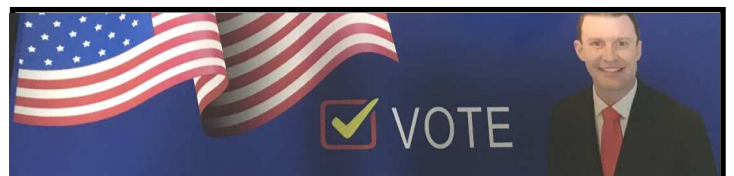
