The Weather

The High Yesterday: 56° The Low this Morning: 30°



The cloudy skies today will keep the high temperatures in the 50's, but will help keep the overnight low temperatures above freezing.

Beginning tomorrow the forecasters say that we will see near normal temperatures and dry weather. It may feel cooler, but high's in the upper 50's and lows in the upper 30's is normal for December. Things should be warming up next week.

Today: Increasing clouds with a slight chance of drizzle into the early afternoon. The high will be near 54°. Winds will be light from the W-SW.

Tonight: Cloudy with gradual clearing and a slight chance of sprinkles overnight. The low should be near 36°, and W-NW wind at 5-10mph

Sunday, Sunny with a high near 60°. Winds will be blustery from the NW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Sunday Night: Mostly clear, with a low around 35°. Light NW wind will become calm.

Monday: Sunny, with a high near 65°. Light N-NW winds at 5 mph.

Please note that the quality of our broadcast depends on available bandwidth, and a little luck in this uncharted- ground enterprise.



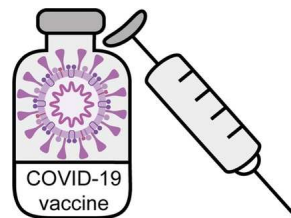
A Very Concerning Local Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that **Lampasas County saw the biggest increase in cases to date yesterday with an increase of 63 cases for 672 total cases. The active cases in Lampasas County jumped to 94, an increase of 35 since yesterday morning's 59, and 8 Lampasans are hospitalized. There were also 2 additional fatalities in our county, both gentlemen in their 70's.**



Dr. Hay also shared that "most hospitals are running out of staff even though they still have beds. She said the staff shortage is widespread, and it affects us locally and for our ability to transfer out." She stresses that residents need to wear their mask, limit gatherings, and the same things we did this summer. The State of Texas recorded 13,581 new cases yesterday and 9,015 Texans are hospitalized.

Who will be Receiving the 1st Covid-19 Vaccines?



According to a schedule released Friday by the Texas Department of State Health Services, Baylor Scott & White Medical Center/Temple will receive 3900 doses of the Covid-19 vaccine in the 1st week of allocations. Hospitals in Waco and in Round Rock will also see the vaccine delivered. The schedule is

Lampasas Police Dept. Blotter for Friday shows a reported harassment in the 100 block of E. 5th St. at 10am. The afternoon shows a reported fraud in the 600 block of N. Key at 2:07pm, a burglary of a habitation in the 1300 block of E. 4th St. at 3:34pm, possession of marijuana reported on Samac Lane at 3:52pm, and a theft in the 1700 block of CTE at 8:18pm.

Lampasas Sherriff's Blotter for Friday shows Lometa with a request for extra patrol. In Kempner there were livestock issues, a burglary in progress, an abandoned vehicle, a reported disturbance and a medical call. Out in the county there was a fish & game call, a requested for a welfare check, a noise complaint and a medical call. Deputies went into Cove on livestock issues.

Annual Toy Run Sunday

The Lampasas Police Dept. posed that on Sunday, December 6th, 2020, the TriCounty Toy Run of Central Texas will be holding their 28th Annual TriCounty Toy Run. This event provides many children in the Central Texas area with toys during this holiday season.

The run which will include motorcycles and many other motor vehicles to include law enforcement, fire department and first responder vehicles will leave Temple on Sunday and make their way to Putters and Gutters and Grace Fellowship Parking lot in Lampasas. This event is very well received and could have thousands of motorcycles and motor vehicles in the procession.

They plan to leave Temple at 1:00 p.m. on Sunday and travel west from Temple to Copperas Cove, traveling on Central Texas Expressway/190/I-14. In Copperas Cove, they will move to the left lane and merge onto the 190 South loop towards Kempner, continuing to travel west to Lampasas. At the Old Copperas Cove Road ramp, the ramp will be controlled by law enforcement while the TOY RUN proceeds west. The Toy Run will continue on Hwy. 190 heading west and at the FM2657 intersection there will be law enforcement to control the intersection. They will continue west, at the Big Divide Road and thru the main lighted intersection in Kempner, law enforcement will assist with control of the intersections so the TOY RUN can safely proceed.

They estimate to arrive at Putters and Gutters at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday. Once they enter the City of Lampasas, law enforcement and first responders will assist at the following intersections to help with safe passage of the procession: East 4th Street and 190 (the Walmart Intersection), 190 and 183 (190 and Key Avenue) as

the Toy Run continues west onto Ohmneiss. At the Ohmneiss and South 281 intersection the Toy Run will make a left (south) turn and continue south on 281 to Putters and Gutters. Non-emergency vehicles will turn into the Putters and Gutters parking lot and emergency vehicles will park at Grace Fellowship. Law enforcement will be assisting with traffic control in this area and with controlled pedestrian crossings. Please use extra caution on Sunday, if you are traveling along these areas. Remember no parking on right of ways from Ohmneiss to city limits on South 281 either side, and no Pedestrian crossing except at the Ohmneiss and 281 intersection and the High School Intersection. If you are attending the event please remember to use COVID precautions. This event is a very well planned and organized event, please use caution and follow directions of emergency responders that will be assisting with traffic direction and control for the safety of all.
