The Weather

The sunny skies today will make for a warm afternoon, possibly in to the lower 70's. Tomorrow is expected to be another warm sunny day possibly reaching the upper 70's, and again on Thursday. Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay shared with Lampasas Radio this morning that Lampasas County now has 698 total cases, up from 672 on Saturday. There are 76 active cases, 18 less than on Saturday. Dr. Hay shared that 5 residents of Lampasas County are in the hospital with Covid-19, and we have had 14 fatalities.

The State of Texas saw 8,712 new cases yesterday and 8,790 Texans are hospitalized with Covid-19.

Lampasas ISD as of 11/30/2020 is reporting the following cases; Hanna Springs Elementary- 2 active /5 recovered students and 0 active/7 recovered staff. Kline Whitis Elementary shows 0 active/2 recovered students and 0 active/recovered staff. Taylor Creek Elementary-1 active/recovered students and 0 active/3 recovered staff. Lampasas Middle School shows 3 active/6 recovered students and 0 active/1 recovered staff. Lampasas High School reports 4 active /37 recovered students and 1 active/12 recovered staff.

Lampasas ISD STAAR Testing This Week



According to Dr. Kevin Bott, Assistant Superintendent for Lampasas ISD, Lampasas High School has approximately 50 students taking end-of-course STAAR exams this week. Dr. Bott is thankful that we were able to return to in-person learning this week at the high school campus. Many students need accommodations, extra time, an extra day or other specific needs.

Dr. Bott shares that "Thank goodness for the Lampasas ISD community of teachers and staff. Whether in-person, remote, or a

combination, our district is getting it done. Our students are receiving a quality education in these uncharted waters. Thank you to the LISD staff."

Death of Burnet CISD Middle School Principal

The following is a letter to the community from Keith Mc Burnett:

Dear Burnet CISD Staff and Community,



We are deeply saddened at the loss of Burnet Middle School
Principal Jeremy LeJeune. Mr.
LeJeune had long battled a rare blood vessel disorder that required hospital visits and admissions. Although he was feeling well at the beginning of the weekend, he recognized that he needed to go to the hospital. As part of

the routine admission process, he tested positive for COVID-19. Although he was asymptomatic, it is likely that the virus exacerbated his condition. He passed away in the hospital on Sunday evening. He was present at Burnet Middle School on Friday, and contact tracing is taking place this morning, but at this time, we do not believe that any students, staff, or visitors will be considered close contacts because safety protocols were followed carefully. If someone is deemed as close contact, they will be notified immediately.

Our hearts go out to Mr. LeJeune's family, to the Burnet Middle School staff and students, and the larger educational community in which Mr. LeJeune was an active participant. He was President-Elect of the Texas Association of Secondary School Principals Executive Board, and in 2018-2019 he was named TASSP Region 13 Middle School Principal of the Year. Mr. LeJeune loved his family very much. He was a devout Christian, an avid UT football fan, and he loved being principal of Burnet Middle School and serving the staff and students there. Additional counselors will present on campus throughout today, and we will continue to support the school community through this difficult loss. Thank you for your continued thoughts and prayers.
