The Weather

Today: A mostly sunny day with a high of 80°. Wind will be SW at 10-15 mph gusting to 20 mph.

Extensive investigation has been done and nothing has been substantiated. The LHS campus will be in full operation tomorrow. Thank you."

This morning Dr. Chane Rascoe spoke with Lampasas Radio and stated "this has been investigated, and as Mr. McQueen's statement stated yesterday there is no credibility to this, and the kids are safe."

Dr. Rascoe reiterated that if anyone hears of a credible threat to contact school officials immediately.
