The Weather

High yesterday was 73° The low this morning was 50°

Today: Sunny with a high near 73° and the calm wind will shift to southerly around 5 mph this afternoon.

Tonight: Partly cloudy with a low around 52° and S-SE wind around 5 mph.

Saturday: Mostly sunny with a mid-afternoon high that could reach 77° short-sleeve weather with a 5-10 mph south wind. When the Carol of Lights courthouse lighting ceremony kicks off Saturday evening downtown Lampasas it should be about 65-71° and mid-60s by the time the parade is over. South wind will be 5-10 mph.

Rest of the week: Sunday will be another nice day with a high around 74° and partly sunny with light south wind. Clouds will come in Sunday night and Monday has a 20% chance of rain that increases to 50% on Tuesday, back to 20% on Wednesday. It will get cooler next week.

Local Man Arrested For Aggravated Robbery



In a traffic stop in the 100 block of Ohnmeiss Thursday morning a local man, 40 yr old Franklin Monroe Dumas was arrested on a Travis County warrant for aggravated robbery with a deadly weapon.

The felony offense brought Lampasas Radio to obtain a copy of the probable cause affidavit, filed in Travis County. The document notes that the offense occurred on October 4th when Dumas is alleged to have been spotted in the process of burglarizing a vehicle belonging to Roxane Kelly Davis. Another man and woman, Trey and Michelle, seemed to have been at Roxane's home at the time, working.

It says that Roxane spotted a man (Dumas) taking things from her driver's side door, and ran to confront him. He ran away, then she noticed her phone was missing as Dumas ran toward the van belonging to Trey, with Michelle standing by it. He grabbed Michelle and grabbed bags out of Trey's van. Roxane ran toward them, screaming "give me back my phone" and Dumas grabbed her hand. She noticed he had a knife, saying "I'll stab you bitch" over and over. Michelle then told Roxane that she would get her phone back. At that, Dumas dropped the phone and ran away, but with Michelle, up the driveway along the fence line. Roxane called 911 and chased them up the street to get the license plate. Roxane states he still had the knife in

his hands as he drove off toward FM 1431. Roxane said she later discovered her car keys had been taken as well.

The alleged, curious, botched car burglary leaves a lot of questions, but Dumas was still in Lampasas County Jail this morning and the Travis Co. Sheriff's Office listed a bond of \$30,000.

Burnet Co. Officer Involved Shooting

Another incident on Thursday, this involved a 10:11pm incident where an off-duty Austin Police Officer on FM 1431 near Marble Falls shot a road-rage driver that was firing a pistol.

Statements of involved parties indicate that the driver had exited his vehicle with a handgun and pointed it at the other vehicle, which was occupied by a family of three. The off-duty Austin PD officer drove on the scene at that moment while on his way home. The suspect and officer exchanged gunfire and the suspect was wounded twice. While gunfire was being exchanged, the family of three successfully escaped into nearby brush.

The suspect was located unconscious in nearby brush and was airlifted to Dell Seton Medical Center with non-life-threatening injuries. He was listed in stable condition as of this morning.

The Burnet County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division, with the assistance of the Texas Rangers, are investigating the incident.
