The Weather



The high yesterday 77° This morning's low 41°

The warm air and sunny skies will bring us a very warm day, near the 80° mark. Clouds will move in this evening from the west to the east and showers will begin to develop in West Texas and are expected to increase in coverage in Central Texas during the late evening and overnight hours, and the clouds will keep lows in the 50's with a strong south wind. Look for the rain to continue on Friday as a cold front approaches. Saturday's highs are forecast to be in the low 60's in our area, then another cool front is expected to move through on Sunday, though the rain should not be widespread.

Today: Sunny with a high near 79°. S-SW winds will be increasing to 10-15 mph this afternoon, gusting to 20 mph.

Tonight: Increasing clouds with a low around 57° and a 20% chance of showers. Winds will be S at 5-10 mph.

Friday: Cloudy in the morning with a 40% chance of showers, then clearing with a high near 72°. Wind will be W-SW at 5-15 mph with possible gusts of 20 mph.

Overnight Friday: Mostly clear with a low near 40°. Winds will become light from the north.

Saturday: Sunny with a high temperature near 61°. Winds will be N near 5-10 mph.

Saturday Night: A low near 39° and mostly clear skies. Winds will become calm.

Lady Badger Varsity Basketball Coach Mark Myers visited the Lampasas Radio Studios this morning, along with Lady Badger Addison McDonald (below) for an interview with Ronnie Witcher. Coach Myers has 38 years of Girls Varsity Basketball under his belt, with 896 wins making him the 4th most winning coach in Girls Basketball in Texas. The Lady Badgers have played 8 games this year so far, and have an 8-0 record. The ladies



have seen 2 games cancelled due to virus issues, which Coach Myers said they are expecting. He shared that the girls were playing well. This is his 4th year in the system and with the girls working together for that time, he said they are now able to run more plays and strategies that they all find fun.

The Ladies played Lago Vista Tuesday and only the JV lost, but he says the girls now look and see what could have been done differently for a different outcome. Lampasas Lady Badgers are in a new district this year, Region 1, District 6 which also includes Brownwood, Gatesville, Glen Rose, and Stephenville. In that

district there are 3 undefeated teams. He says the girls are watching the videos of their opponents, getting up to speed. As for the virus issues, he is adamant that these students get their best chance at school and on the team. The team undertakes many sanitizing procedures to protect all those involved. Addison McDonald, senior captain of the team was here this morning, and she is the team's lead scorer and plays mostly at the guard position. Addison is also 1st in her class, homecoming queen, Spring Ho Queen, so is an all around student athlete. Ms. McDonald says that she sees better team chemistry and they read each other better now that they have worked together for several years. She shared that she started basketball in the 1st grade, moved to a travel team in 4th grade and then as a Lady Badger. Addison opted for remote learning at this time, as there have been 24 cases at the high school since the shut-down, and double hospitalizations.

Lets hope for the best for our Lady Badgers!

Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay reported this morning that Lampasas County now has 723 total cases, (an increase of 4 since yesterday), 93 active cases (an increase of 4 from yesterday), and 6 in the hospital (down 1 from yesterday) at this time.

The State of Texas had 10,930 new cases reported and 9,053 Texans were hospitalized as of yesterday.

Lampasas ISD on 12/9/20 reports the increase of 1 active case at Hanna Springs Elementary (student), and Lampasas Middle School (student), Lampasas High School shows and increase of 2 student/active cases and 2 virtual student/active cases.

Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced today he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts \$790 million in local sales tax allocations for December. These allocations are based on sales made in October by businesses that report tax monthly.



In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate check decrease by 30.74%, with a \$3663.54 rebate, last year the rebate for Evant for this time period was \$5290.11. The city of Hamilton in Hamilton County saw a 12.46% decrease in their rebate check of \$53,732.65.

In Lampasas County Lometa received a rebate check for \$7991.09 a 29.43% increase. Kempner received a rebate for \$10,348.77, a 1.59% decrease. The city of Lampasas saw a 24.50% increase in sales tax rebates, for a total of \$203,221.86.
