Commissioners Meeting



The Lampasas County Commissioners held their regular scheduled meeting yesterday at 9am at the Lampasas County Courthouse. The consent agenda was accepted as presented. No public comments were made.

Approved were revisions to the county utility

installation permit procedures. The commissioners are now allowed to make decisions concerning bores being made to the roads in their respective precincts. The Commissioners will no longer have to present these to the County Commissioners Court.

There was discussion on creating a position for grounds and preventative maintenance for the new jail. This position is to include the grounds around the Courthouse, the Annex Building and the Old Jail. There was discussion on using a trustee for the position. Commissioner Bobby Carol stated" if we hire a person to watch someone do the job, might as well just hire someone to do the job." The commissioners will be going over funds to create and provide tools for the maintenance job . After cost is determined, they will take applications and conduct interviews. Ultimately, the motion to create a grounds maintenance position was approved. This will be discussed more in January.


