The Weather

Yesterday's high 77° This morning's low 66°



Today: Mostly cloudy skies and a high near 74°. Look for patchy fog this morning and a 40% chance of showers and storms this afternoon. Wind will become light.

Tonight: Look for mostly cloudy skies and a low near 57° with some fog possible tomorrow morning. There is a 70% chance of precipitation and wind will become N-NE near 5 mph overnight.

Sunday: Mostly cloudy skies and the high temperature will climb to near 64°. Wind will be N-NE near 5 mph becoming calm.
