The Weather



The High yesterday was 69° The Low this morning 41°

Today: Sunny with a high near 76° and W-SW wind between 5 and 10 mph.

Tonight: Partly cloudy as a new, short term cold front comes in with a low around 40° and N-NW wind around 5-10 mph.

Tuesday: It will be sunny, with a high near 60° as the cold front does its thing. It will drop the temperature down to 32° and a possible light freeze overnight. All the while, a light northerly wind will blow.

The Week

Today, Dec. 11th

Lampasas County Commissioners will meet at 9am in the courthouse. On the agenda is a recognition of School Choice Week, then a memorandum of understanding with the Texas Attorney General's office. Sable Reynolds will be considered for membership in the Lampasas County Historical Commission. There will be discussions related to the new county jail project and the draft ideas for a construction contract, and there will be an executive session with an attorney.

There will be an additional "called" meeting of the court with department heads at 1:30pm in the Annex Conference Room.

Lampasas City Council will meet at 5:30pm for a workshop. Much of it will include a 2018 Council Work Plan, then the idea of the City being a Credit Card Friendly Destination.

In the 7pm regular session there will be the usual reports, then possible action appointing Mandy Walsh to the Development District of Central Texas as the City's representative, a possible agreement between the City and the Lampasas County Riding Club concerning the 580 Sports Park's Rodeo Arena property, and a vendor agreement with Hill Country Community Action Association regarding pledges for utility accounts. There will also be budget amendments and a possible agreement on a Bark for Life event at Hanna Springs Sculpture Garden on Jan. 28th.

Tuesday, Dec 12th

Kempner City Council will meet at 7pm for a regular session in City Hall. In addition to regular financial matters they will discuss a PEC Franchise Agreement, a stoplight issue at 190 and FM 2808, the CAD Board Members Election, a note on COP-sync's bankruptcy proceeding, and the Texas Senate Commendation for Police Chief Spence.

Perception Creative Art School will have its 3rd Annual 12X12 Dinner and Show at 6:30pm. This year it's the Yumm Rocks ART event with a Private Dinner by Yumm Again catering. It's all taking place at the school and Yumm Again location on Third Street. There'll be with Live Music & Viewing of the art with the music by Derek Groves, Cord Jackson, John Groves and Allison Hendrick. After the dinner and viewing, there will be a sale of the 12X12 canvas art that has been on display. (Cont. on back)

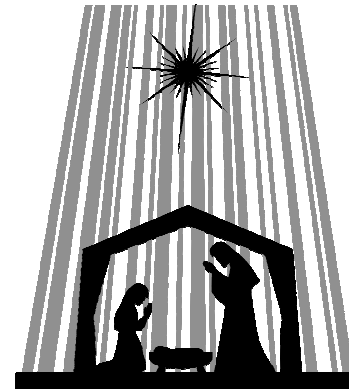

Head Coach Aaron Nuckles' Varsity (11-5), had a disappointing night at the Hamilton tournament, losing the Championship game 71-74 to Dublin, a team they had soundly defeated earlier in the tournament. Kyle Sims led the team in the effort with 19 points, 10 rebounds, 5 assists and 2 steals. Austin Martin had 18, Xavier Nix 11(pix) and Philip Blackstock 11.
