The Weather

The cold front is expected to be through our area late this afternoon. Look for a cooler overnight as the gusty NW winds usher in the cool airmass. Winds should diminish in the night, but windchills will be a factor tomorrow morning. Tomorrow will be cooler but with lots of sunny skies. High temperatures are forecast in the low 60's on Saturday. Another front is expected to move across the area on Sunday which will drive low temperatures into the 20's on Sunday night.

Today: Cloudy this morning with showers until lunch time, then clearing and an expected high near 74°. The S wind at 5-10 mph will shift to the W in the afternoon and may gust up to 20 mph.

Tonight: Look for mostly clear skies, and a low near 40°. Light winds will become N-NW in the night.

Saturday: Sunny with a high near 62° and with calm wind making for a pretty nice day.

Saturday night: Look for mostly clear sky and probably getting down to 41° with calm wind becoming light S-SE.

Sunday: A slight chance of rain in the morning, then sunny in the afternoon with a high near 64°. Winds will shift to the NW in the afternoon at 15-20 m,ph gusting to 30mph.

Ovenight Sunday: Partly cloudy and cold with a low near 29°. Gusty N winds should decrease in the night

Coronavirus Update

Dr. Hay reported this morning that Lampasas County now has 734 total cases,(an increase of 11 since yesterday), 86 active cases(a decrease of 7 from yesterday), and 8 in the hospital (up 2 from yesterday) at this time.

The State of Texas had 12,211 new cases reported and 9,045 Texans were hospitalized as of yesterday.

Lampasas ISD as of 12/10/2020 is reporting the following cases; Hanna Springs Elementary- 3 active /5 recovered students and 0 active/7 recovered staff. Kline Whitis Elementary shows 0 active/2 recovered students and 0 active/recovered staff. Taylor Creek Elementary-2 active/0 recovered students and 0 active/3 recovered staff. Lampasas Middle School shows 5 active /7 recovered students and 0 active/1 recovered staff. Lampasas High School reports 8 active /37 recovered students, 2 active/0 recovered virtual students, and 1 active/12 recovered staff.

121 Year Old Area Church Burns

According to "The DailyTrib.com" in Burnet County, The Texas State Fire Marshal's Office is investigating a blaze that destroyed a historic church in northeast Burnet County during the night Dec. 9. The Bertram Volunteer Fire Department, Oakalla Volunteer Fire Department, and Burnet Volunteer Fire Department responded to a fire at the Mahomet Christian Church in the 10,000 block of FM 243 near the U.S. 183 intersection at about 11pm Wednesday.

The church formed around 1851, likely in nearby Sycamore Springs. According to a Texas Historical Commission marker in Mahomet,

the church moved from Sycamore Springs to its current site in 1899, making it one of the oldest continuously operating churches in Burnet County.

The cause of the fire is under investigation. Burnet County has experienced a string of suspicious fires since May.

A GoFundMe account has been set up to help the congregation and community rebuild the church.
