Public Hearing Monday

The Lampasas County Commissioners Court will hold a public hearing this Monday, December 13th at 9am in the Commissioners Courtroom concerning proposed revisions to the Lampasas County Manufactured Home Community Regulations.



Following the hearing, there will be a regularly scheduled Commissioners meeting beginning at 9:15am. The agenda includes the consent agenda, monthly reports from County offices the sheriff's report, discussion of the Adult Sexual Response Team, replacement of software for the appraisal of all property, and collection and distribution of taxes, discussion of manufactured homes community regulations, budget amendments, considering options to holdover that constable from precinct 4, and adoption of an order conforming election precincts with commissioner, justice of the peace and constable precincts.

The county commissioners will also be holding a workshop meeting on Monday at 1pm in the Lampasas County Commissioners Courtroom to discuss abatement and demolition bids.

City Council to Meet

The Lampasas City Council will meet beginning with a workshop session Monday at 5:30pm. The Workshop session will include discussion of the Georgetown Tank mixing upgrade to improve disinfectant levels, a Covid-19 update, and the engineering related to the relocation of water lines due to TxDOT 281 improvement project.

The regular meeting will start at 6pm and the agenda includes a public hearing to receive citizen comments regarding a specific use permit for property known as 2209 S. Highway 183 to allow for the sale of storage buildings. There will also be a public hearing concerning enlarging and extending the boundary line of the city. The agenda also includes the consent agenda, which includes the second reading of an ordinance to vacate and convey the alley in block 76, Lampasas springs Company 1st addition. There will be routine matters, the City Manager's Operational report and mayor's comments. In new business, there will be discussion of the wastewater project on W. Ave C, the specific use permit for 2209 S. Hwy 183 for the sale of storage buildings, approval of the final plat of the Oncken-Sheppard Lane subdivision, voluntary annexation of 4 acres in the Hidden Oaks Subdivision, adoption of the budget for the municipal government of the City of Lampasas; for the fiscal year 2021. Also discussed will be the purchase of 2 police interceptor police units, and 2 Motorola In Car video camera systems. Discussion of the award of a professional engineering proposal by Eckermann Engineering to design water line relocations due to the TxDOT 281 project, and discussion of the Tideflex mixing system to be installed during the Georgetown ground storage tank rehabilitation project.



Utility Scam

In a post by the Lampasas Police Dept., we find that a Lampasas County resident received two calls telling them if they didn't pay their utility bill to the caller in less than 35 minutes their utilities were going to be disconnected.

If you receive a phone call from a person claiming that you have minutes to make a past due utility payment before your utilities are shut off or disconnected--- do not be scammed by the urgency to pay.

If you question the Scammer, knowing your payment has been made, they will try to convince you that maybe your payment didn't clear the bank and you need to pay now to prevent your utilities from being shut off or disconnected.

If you question them about the number they are calling from. They are quick to tell you that they are making courtesy calls for all rural area utility companies to help you from having your utilities shut off or disconnected.

If you receive a similar call and have reason for concern that for whatever reason your utilities maybe about to be shut off or disconnected, call your utility company at the number the utility

company provides and not the number displayed on the Caller ID. Be smart and don't be a victim of the Utility Scam!
