Sales Tax Reports Are In!

Once again, the City of Lampasas, as well as Lometa and Kempner, see increased sales tax collections for the fall.


This tally is for the sales tax collected by stores in the county for the month of October, turned in to the state in November and now "divvied up" in December. The Cities' parts are as follows:

Lampasas gets \$163,225, up 4.86% from Dec. 2018 Lometa gets \$6,173, up 3.1% and Kempner will get \$10,516, which is up 41.82%. The large increase for Kempner has to do with different reporting periods.

Burnet County cities show large increases with Burnet's check for \$212,328 up 11.9% for this year and Granite Shoals, Bertram and Cottonwood Shores all having double digit increases. Marble Falls had just a .56% increase this time but their check was \$753, 486.

San Saba gets a check for \$39,220, down .2% from last year while Goldthwaite's \$37,890 check was 6% higher. Copperas Cove gets \$426,914, which is down 3.86%.

County Owed \$19,230,000 At End Of 2018



Ouch! According to the State Comptroller's Office, every man, woman and child in Lampasas Co. at the end of 2018 owed \$906 in County debt. That is the debt per capita number for Lampasas County. (This is in addition to the debt the City and School District's have.)

The big debt hike was brought on by the ongoing construction of the new Lampasas County Jail and Law Enforcement Center. It was the result of the \$18,750,000 bond approval by county voters in 2017. Data was not available on how much more the debt will grow for 2019 or 2020 as the jail project is still not finished. At last Monday's County Commissioner meeting the indications were that it is close.
