Weather

High yesterday was 60° Low this morning was 41°

Today: Sunny with a high near 71°. Wind will be W-NW at 10-15 mph.

Tonight: Clear with a low near 42°. Winds will continue to be W-NW at 5-10 mph.

Saturday: Sunny skies with a high near 72°. W-NW wind at 5-10 mph becoming E-SE in the afternoon.

Saturday night: S-SE wind at 5-10 mph with clear skies and a low of 49°.

Sunday: Sunny with a high temperature near 78°. Winds will be S-SW at 10 mph.

Overnight: Partly cloudy and a low near 49°. Winds will be W-SW at 5-10 mph after midnight.

Next week: The SW winds will likely bring in temperatures approaching 80° on Sunday. Then it looks like the front will push SE across the region Sunday night. A much colder airmass will follow the front with temperatures only reaching into the 40's and 50's for Monday, then drop into the 20's and 30's Monday night. Tuesday should be our coldest night, with most everyone in the mid to upper 20's Wednesday morning.

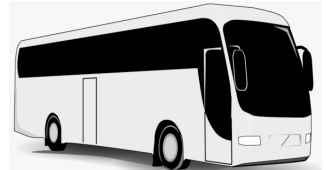

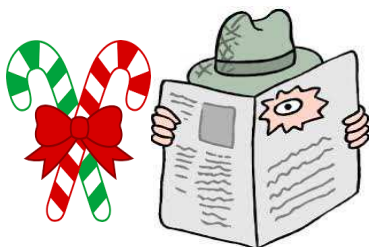

Lampasas Police Increase Traffic Enforcement

Lt. Chuck Montgomery shared the following with Lampasas Radio:

"The holiday season can be a dangerous time for alcohol-related crashes, deaths and injuries on Texas roadways. In 2018, there were 2,370 DUI-alcohol related crashes in Texas during the holiday season.

* These crashes killed 75 people and seriously injured another 199. In response, Lampasas Police Department and law enforcement officers across Texas will increase DWI patrols to identify and stop impaired drivers as part of TxDOT's "Plan While You Can" campaign. The campaign aims to decrease crashes and save lives by urging drivers to plan a sober ride prior to driving to their holiday celebrations. The increased enforcement begins today and runs through Jan. 1, 2020.

"Drunk driving crashes are 100% preventable. There is no excuse for getting behind the wheel while impaired." Said Patrol Lieutenant Chuck Montgomery. "We urge drivers to take the simple step of planning ahead for a sober ride. It's a decision that can save a life." While driving under the influence of alcohol risks death or serious injuries it can also be costly. Drivers can face up to \$17,000 in fines and fees, jail time and loss of their driver's license Lampasas Police Department and TxDOT strongly encourage everyone to plan for a sober ride before the celebrations begin. Visit SoberRides.org to find alternatives to drinking alcohol and driving, such as:

- Designating a sober driver
- Calling a cab or ride-share service
- Using mass transit
- Asking a sober friend or family member for a ride
- Spending the night

More Roadwork on US 190

This in from TxDOT:

"LAMPASAS COUNTY – The Texas Department of Transportation's contractor will begin maintenance work on US 190 East, from Lampasas to the Coryell County line, beginning Monday, December 16.

This work will encompass the entirety of US 190 E in Lampasas, which includes the intersection at the entrance to Walmart in Lampasas. Crews will work to seal cracks to prolong the life of the roadway. This operation will require lane closures. Motorists are encouraged to allow extra time when traveling in this area. This crack sealing operation will continue throughout Lampasas County on the following roadways:

US 183 N – From Lometa to Lampasas, including the entirety of Key Avenue in Lampasas

FM 580 E – From the eastern city limits of Lampasas to the Coryell County line

FM 580 W – From Key Avenue to Dana Street

US 281 N – From the intersection of FM 1690 to Lampasas

Work in Lampasas County is expected to be completed by the end of the week, weather permitting.

Motorists are asked to use caution and slow their speed in areas of construction.
