

Commissioners Court

The Lampasas County Commissioners held a regularly scheduled meeting Monday morning to discuss the redistricting of county political boundaries, the vacant lot of the old county jail/ sheriff's office, a fireworks ban, and the recognition of County Clerk Connie Hartman's retirement among other items.

Discussion over possible county redistricting took place with Commissioner Mark Rainwater expressing concern over the 2020 census, advocating for another redistricting process to occur. A motion to call a special meeting and public hearing on December 27th was passed unanimously to further discuss the county political boundaries.

Due to the public auction for the vacant lot leading to no outcome, public comments were taken to suggest possible solutions. A

motion to transform the vacant lot into a parking lot was passed unanimously after public discussion. A motion to order a fireworks ban that will limit the sale of certain fireworks (i.e sky rocket, sky flyer) was passed. The recognition of County Clerk Connie Hartman's retirement took place during the meeting. Hartman worked nearly 40 years through 6 county judges and 20 county commissioners.

Lampasas City Council

Wednesday: Mostly cloudy skies with gradual clearing and a high The Lampasas City Council held a regularly scheduled meeting Monday evening to discuss Solar Photovoltaic (PV) systems, city project updates, solar eclipse preparation, and the city manager's operational report among other topics.

> PV systems and the need to ensure electric customers when switching from electricity to solar generation were discussed briefly. From 2020-2021, PV systems saw a 30% increase in Texas. 31 households in Lampasas currently have a PV system.

> A city projects update shows that Harrison Construction has completed the base pad for the skate park. SPA Skateparks is expected to be onsite within the next three weeks to start the concrete portion of construction and completion. The business park is estimated to be at 99% completion. The only remaining items include hydrant plugs, (cont'd on back)

(cont'd from front) five storm drains that need to be grouted, as well as the coating and sealing of manholes. On November 8th, the city issued a Notice to Proceed to WT Construction beginning on November 18th. WT Construction began demo work at the Industrial Park the week of November 28th.

Current planning efforts for the solar eclipse event (April 2024) were discussed briefly. The event is expected to bring an estimated 100,000 people to the immediate area. Staff on the project have developed an emergency management plan, increased levels of training, and designed tabletop exercises in preparation for the event.

The city manager's operational report begins with an update on the airport planning project. The scope of the project will include a layout plan update, inventory of assets, aviation forecast, and identification of short and long-term needs. Contracting by TxDOT will be completed this winter with the final draft before launch.

The EMS report shows 151 calls made within the city of Lampasas, while 101 calls were made outside Lampasas. Average response time in the city was 5 minutes and 24 seconds. The report also notes continued, cooperative training with the Lampasas Fire Department.

Annual Tree-Trimming

The City of Lampasas has contracted with McCoy Tree Surgery in implementing a Tree Trimming Program around City Electric Lines. This program began on December 12th, 2022 and will be completed about mid-February.

The First area to be trimmed is West Ave. E to North Ave, from Key Ave to Porter.

The Second area to be trimmed will be North Ave to 6th Street, from Key Ave to Porter.

Homeowners will be notified by door tags, in advance, of the trees being trimmed in their area or on their property.
