

The Weather



High yesterday was 67° The low this morning was 44°

Today: Partly sunny and up to near 65° this afternoon but, the north wind is returning with a new cold front this afternoon. Look for N-NW wind to come in at 5-15 mph with gusts to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy, with a low around 38°, and with the N-NW wind the cold is riding on fairly light at 5-10 mph.

Friday: Mostly sunny and a high near 58° with the wind N-NW at 5-10 mph. Overnight the temps will drop to 36° just as the front finishes up and the wind shifts back to southerly.

The weekend: The Saturday forecast shows mid-50s highs and rain chances increasing as the wind shift brings S-SW wind gusting to 20 mph. Rain chances are 30% on Saturday and 50% Saturday night. The start on Sunday morning will be in the low 40s and it will warm up to somewhere near 70° Sunday afternoon.

In addition to electing officers, there was discussion on ways to increase membership. 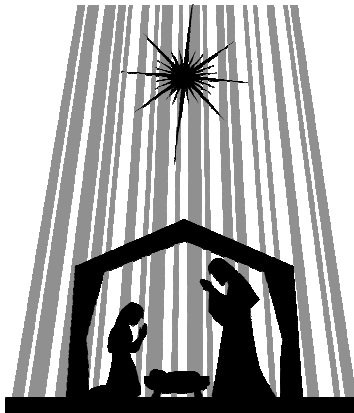

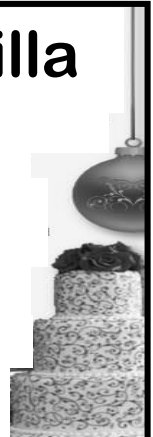

The Blotter
