District Court

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27th District Court Docket Call on December 10th. Presiding over the Court was 27th District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 30 cases were brought to the court with 29 cases involving men, and 1 case involving a woman.

There were 11 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 4 cases for less than a gram, 4 cases for 1-4 grams, and 1 case for 4-200 grams. There was one case for possession of a controlled substance PG 2 1-4 grams, and one case for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone. There was 1 DWI case.

There were 3 cases for evading arrest and 4 for burglary. There was one case each for engaging in organized criminal activity, one case of criminal mischief and one robbery case, there were 2 theft cases,

There was 1 cases for assault on a family member, one case for stalking and one for failure to comply with sex offender

registration. There were 3 cases of indecency with a child/sexual contact.

Of the cases heard, 8 were settled. Nick Santini was sentenced to 2 years probation plus court costs for engaging in organized criminal activity. Noah Williams was sentenced to 3 years probation for possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram. Ivan Espinoza, on the charge of evading arrest with a vehicle/watercraft was sentenced to 4 years at TDCJ with credit for days already served. Justin Willis of Temple plead guilty to 3 counts of burglary of a building and was sentenced to 4 years TDCJ on each count with credit for days served. Brian Acosta, on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram in a drug free zone, plead guilty and was sentenced to 3 years TDCJ. Stetson James-Levy on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram was sentenced to 2 days in the county jail with credit for 2 days, plus restitution, court costs and a fine.

The rest of the cases were reset or had dates set for jury trials.

Tree Trimming Time

The City of Lampasas has contracted with McCoy Tree Surgery to implement a Tree Trimming Program around City Electric Lines. This program will begin on December 20th, and will be completed about mid-February.

The First area to be trimmed is 1st Street to Nix Road from Steele to Porter. The Second area to be trimmed is 1st Street to 7th Street from Samac to Porter. The Third area to be trimmed is Naruna Road from Howe to South HWY 281 and on Howe from Naruna heading north. The Fourth area to be trimmed is West Avenue E to 1st Street from Porter to Key Avenue. The Fifth area to be trimmed is 1st Street to 6th Street from Porter to Key Avenue. Homeowners will be notified by door tags in advance of the trees being trimmed in their area or on their property.

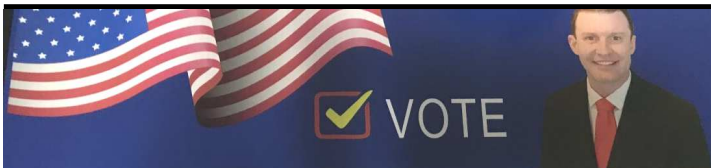

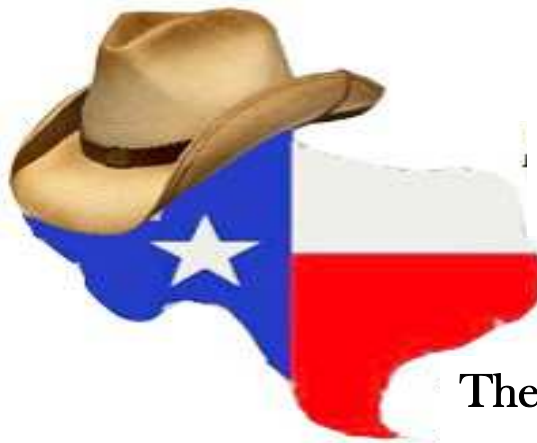

The Blotter

Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 3,434 new and 1,207 probable new cases on December 14th, along with 68 deaths. There were also 3,204 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 0 new confirmed cases in Lampasas County on December 14th, and 32 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 56 active cases at this time.

Middle School Basketball

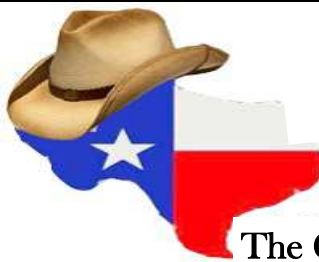
