## Weather

The cold front that arrived today has cleared the area, and the cooler air mass has settled in . Drier air will arrive this morning, ending the drizzle of this morning. Skies will clear from west to east. Winds will be increasing during the day and will be sustained at 15-20 mph with gusts as high as 30 mph. The gusty north winds will begin to weaken Tuesday afternoon, and high temperatures on Wednesday are expected to be in the normal range.

## Lampasas High School Teacher Resigns

**The following** is a copy of the letter sent to parents Friday afternoon regarding a Lampasas High School Teacher.

"Late yesterday, Lampasas ISD learned that a Lampasas High School Teacher engaged in inappropriate texting and communication with a Lampasas High School student. Lampasas ISD responded by immediately contacting the Lampasas Police Department and working with them to begin an immediate investigation. The teacher has been removed from the campus, and the teacher has resigned. The teacher is prohibited from having any contact with Lampasas ISD students or staff and prohibited from entering any district facility.

Lampasas Police Department is actively investigating this issue, and we will cooperate fully with their investigation. While this is a personnel matter, state law limits what information we can share with you, but we wanted you to know as much as we are able to share. We will also refer the matter to the Texas Education Agency for further investigation as well.

Providing our students with a safe environment is our highest priority in Lampasas ISD. Every report made is investigated immediately, the appropriate action is taken, and the outcomes are communicated in a transparent manner. This letter is to make you aware of such an investigation that occurred at the high school campus.

Please know that all Lampasas ISD employees are required to have a background check. Regarding this individual, all background checks were cleared prior to the person starting as a teacher."

### **District Court Notes**

**Lampasas Courthouse** was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on December 13<sup>th</sup>. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Judge John Gauntt.



Altogether 30 cases were brought to the court. 19 of them involved men and 11 involved women. Gary Domhoff of Lampasas failed to appear on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram, and a warrant was issued. Jesse O'Neal was found to have insufficient bond, and a warrant was issued on 1 charge of possession (PG1) less than a gram , and one charge of possession (PG1) 4-200 grams, and a warrant was issued.

There were 17 cases that involved possession of a controlled substance. All were for PG1, with 12 involving less than a gram, 1 involving 1-4 grams, and 4 involving 4-200 grams. There was 1 DWI with felony repetition case. There were 3 theft cases, 1 theft of property, less than \$2,500, one \$1,500-\$20,000, and one involving theft of a firearm. There were 2 forgery cases, and one for credit/debit card abuse. There was one case for evading arrest, and one aggravated assault with a deadly weapon.

Carl Camacho, of Kempner was in court on 3 charges; (1) for employing, authorizing, or inducing a child younger than 18 years of age to engage in sexual conduct or a sexual performance

Joshua Joy of Lampasas pled guilty to possession of a controlled substance (PG1), for which he received 1 day of jail time w/ 1 day of credit, plus court costs and restitution.
