The Weather

The high yesterday 56° This morning's low 29 $^{\circ}$

Even with the sunshine, the forecasters say we will probably top out in the 40's this afternoon. Winds are expected to shift to the S-SW. With the light winds and the dry airmass the temperature will drop to below freezing area wide. The temperatures are expected to rebound a little tomorrow, then another cold front is expected in the Friday night early Saturday time frame. Saturday should bring us afternoon temperatures in the 60's.

Today: Sunny with a high near 51° and N-NW winds at 5-10 mph with possible gusts of 25 mph.

Tonight: Winds will be calm, with mostly clear skies and a low near 29°.

Thursday: Sunny and a high temperature near 62°. Winds will be light form the S-SW shifting south.

Overnight Thursday: Mostly clear with S winds at 5-10 mph, and a low temperature will be near 38°.

Friday: Partly sunny with a high near 63° and S winds at 5-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly cloudy skies and a slight chance of showers in the overnight. The low temperature will be near 45°, Winds will be light from the S at 5-10 mph shifting to the northwest in the night.

Visit with the City Manager

Lampasas City Manger Finley de Graffenried was in

Lampasas Radio studios this morning for his weekly visit with Ronnie Witcher. When visiting about the Covid-19 surge in Lampasas, Mr. de Graffenreid shared that he feels most county residents are responsible and are taking necessary precautions. If the hospital bed availability reaches 15% in our trauma service area, there is a possibility of more lockdowns.



However, he feels Lampasas County will probably not meet these criteria. Mr. Witcher asked about free Covid tests in the area, and the City Manager said there were free tests available in Copperas Cove and Killeen if anyone was interested. He also stated he would try and get that information on the City of Lampasas website.

The safety of the intersection/traffic signal at Lampasas High School & 281S was brought up by a citizen. Mr. de Graffenreid pointed out that that traffic signal has the highest posted speed limit, and the least experienced drivers. He stated that the city would talk to TxDot about signage or something similar to make people aware of that traffic signal. He said a lot of people accelerate at that location, thinking of the 70 mph speed limit further south. He also stated that TxDot will be doing a major upgrade form the County line to Ohnmeiss Dr. & 281 in Lampasas,. Which brought up the increase in travel on highways in our city,

and all corridors have shown about the same amount of growth, 6%. Which in turn, brings new business interests to our city. In executive session Monday a public utility easement was discussed for a business (based in Texas, a Quick Service Restaurant), that wants to locate in Lampasas.

The fire equipment purchase for \$63,509.64 was discussed this morning. It was stated that often times the Lampasas Fire Dept. arrives ahead of Acadian (ambulance company) to a medical emergency, and the new heart monitors/diagnostic tools will put the ambulance crew one step ahead, and better care for the residents of Lampasas.

There will be a holiday schedule posted on the City website, for closings and trash pick-up, and of course, in the Radiogram. Stay safe, be smart!

City Council Planning Retreat

The Lampasas City Council is having a planning retreat



Friday. Council will be reviewing community engagement, needs assessment, capacity building, and future projects. The council will also be brought up-to-date on the City's Comprehensive

Plan during the meeting/retreat.

The itinerary includes an 8:30 am breakfast meeting/review of facilities and plant with the plant staff. At 9:15 the group is scheduled to travel to the Calvert Building for a presentation by Jason Jones, Jones-Heroy consulting engineers, regarding pre-treatment study and recommendations, and council will then discuss the next steps for pre-treatment.

At 10:15am they will tour & review the Information Technology office, and the staff there will have a presentation. Following this will be a discussion of the comprehensive Plan, the status of the plan, priorities and implementation.

Noon will have Council at a working lunch with discussion about the 2021 Council Work Plan, its purpose, goals, planning documents, and budgetary issues. The planning categories are: communication, image and promotion; Community Engagement; Capacity Building, Building Relationships, Expanding resources, professional development and assets and stewardship.

Following the lunch will be a review and summary of identified tasks and unfinished business. The meeting is scheduled to adjourn at 2pm.


The Coronavirus Update


