Citizens Police Academy

The Lampasas Police Department will have another Citizen Police Academy. The Academy will begin on January 6, 2022. The training location will be announced to those granted permission to attend the class. Classes will be held each Tuesday and Thursday night for 12 weeks. Classes are 6pm to 8pm.

What is a Citizen Police Academy?

The Citizen Academy is a group of citizens who are interested in learning more about how their police department operates and the challenges our city faces. We hope our graduates will be more aware and more informed about how our department operates and the challenges law enforcement face each day. We wish to create a growing network of responsible, well-informed citizens who will gain an appreciation of problems and challenges facing law enforcement in our community.

The Academy is offered one time a year with a limit of 25 persons per Academy. *Applications may be picked up and returned to the Lampasas Police Department, 301 East 4th Street, Lampasas, Texas or email Chief Sammy Bailey at sbailey@cityoflampasas.com to have an application emailed to you. Applications must be returned in person. Applications will be accepted until 5:00pm January 3, 2022.*

Classes are free and members of the department and guests will cover a variety of topics that will highlight each departmental unit and its duties. The Academy will begin with an overview of the Academy and department.

Instructors are sworn police officers, personnel of the department, and guest speakers with expertise in their field. Topics will include a State of the City by the City Manager Finley deGraffenried, patrol procedures, street survival, DWI enforcement, narcotics, criminal investigations, court procedures, family violence, animal control-animal shelter, code enforcement, mental health issues, and 911/communications. In addition, we will invite guest speakers to come join us and have additional classes to offer, all free of charge, to the participants of the program. The students will also be given the opportunity to ride with patrol officers on their regular shifts.

Who can attend? (1) You must be at least 18 years of age, (2) reside, own a business, or work in the City of Lampasas. (3) Willing to commit to the days and weeks of training (4) Successfully complete a background investigation

These things can disqualify you: (a) Outstanding warrants of any type. (b) Having a conviction or being under indictment for, or currently charged with any felony offense. (c) Having a history of or conviction for any sexual related offense. (d) Having a history of or conviction of family violence. (e) Having been convicted for a class A misdemeanor within the last ten (10) years. (f) Having been convicted for a class B misdemeanor within the last five (5) year. Sales Tax Rebates

Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar announced last week he will send cities, counties, transit systems and special purpose taxing districts 936million dollars in local sales tax allocations for December. These allocations are based on sales made in October by businesses.

In our area, Evant in Hamilton County saw their rebate check increase by 20.08% over the same period last year, with a \$4399.32 rebate. The City of Hamilton saw a 23.04% increase over the same period last year in their rebate check of \$66,115.38.

In Lampasas County, Lampasas showed there was a small increase of 2.13% increase in their rebate of \$207,570.25. Lometa shows an increase of 18.5% with a rebate check for \$9470.09. Kempner received a rebate for \$10,959.64 a 5.9% increase from last year.



Coronavirus Update

Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 3,498 new and 1448 probable new cases on December 15th, along with 91 deaths. There were also 3,182 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 2 new confirmed cases in Lampasas County on December 15th, and 34 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 57 active cases at this time.
