Badgers Make All-District Team



It seems the Lampasas Badger Football Team is still impacting Texas High School Football.

14 Badgers made the District 14-4A Division 1 All District 1st Team, and Troy Rogers was unanimously voted Coach of the Year.

The Badgers played 5 district games, and put up 159 points to win all of them.

Ace Whitehead was selected the All District MVP by a unanimous vote. At the end of the season, Ace had completed 260 of 373 attempts for passing for a total of 4,259 yards and 54 touchdowns. But that's not all, Ace also rushed for 723 yards and 21 touchdowns. In the District games, Ace had 19 passing touchdowns and 6 rushing touchdowns, and only had 1 interception. Ace also made 1st team defense as kicker.

Also named to the 1st District Team for offense was Jack Jerome (1421 yards rushing, 12 touchdowns), Cameron Everts 90 receptions for 1438 yards and 10 touchdowns), Jaylon Porter (of Monday Night Football fame with 67 receptions, 1352 yards, 20 touchdowns), Brenton Webb (383 yards 8 touchdowns), Austin Kielpinski, John Long, and Daunte Cuffie(818 yards, 12 touchdowns).

The 1st district team defense includes; Daunte Cuffie(134 tackles, 6 sacks), Ethan Rascoe(57 tackles), Koby Allen(191 tackles), Isaiah Rhodes(91 tackles, 10 for a loss), Ace Whitehead, and Clayton Bever(63 tackles 5 interceptions, and averaging 31.3 yards on kickoff returns..

Named to the All-District 2nd team for Offense were Hayden Waldrip and Mike Murray.

The 2nd team defense includes Keagan Richardson, Owerl Seaver, Cade White, and Isaiah Rhodes (both 1st and 2nd team).

Dax Brookreson and Caden Thrift were honorable mentions.
