## District Court Notes

Lampasas County Courthouse was the site of a 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Docket Call on December 16th. Presiding over the Court was 27<sup>th</sup> District Court Judge John Gauntt. Altogether 21 cases were brought to the court with all 21 cases involving men.

There were 6 cases involving possession of a controlled substance/PG1. There were 4 cases for less than a gram, there was 1 case for possession of 4-200 grams. There was also one case for manufacture delivery of a controlled substance PG1 1-4 grams.

There were two cases each for theft of property \$2500-\$30,000, one case for unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and one case of tampering with evidence.

## The Blotter

**The Lampasas County Sheriff's Dep. Blotter** for Friday shows Lometa with an alarm call. (*cont'd from front*) there were 2 cases for aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and one case each for assault on a pregnant person and injury to an elderly/child/disabled person. There were 5 cases of possession w/intent to promote child porn, and one case each for continual sexual abuse of a child under 14 and indecency with a child/sexual contact.

Of the 21 cases 7 were resolved with Calvin Pavey being sentenced on 3 charges: on the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram, Mr. Pavey was sentenced to 10 years TDCJ/probated for 10 years with the stipulation of SAFFP and court costs. On a second charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 less than a gram Mr. Pavey was again sentenced to 10 years TDCJ/probated with the stipulation of SAFFP plus court costs. On the charge of tampering with evidence, Mr. Pavey was sentenced to 2 years TDCJ with credit for days served. On the charge of possession of a controlled substance PG1 4-200 grams Vincent Kitchen of Pflugerville saw his probation modified. Kevin Morrey of Copperas Cove plead guilty to theft of property \$2500-\$30,000 plus enhancements and was sentenced to 4 years TDCJ w/credit for days served. Steven Neal, on the charge of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle plead guilty and was sentenced to 120 days of jail with court costs to run concurrent. Macy Lunsford, on the charge of aggravated assault with a deadly weapon saw his probation amended.

## Earthquake Strikes Near Midland

An earthquake of magnitude 5.3 occurred yesterday afternoon at 5:35 pm local time near Midland, Midland County, Texas, USA, as reported by the United States Geological Survey.

According to preliminary data, the quake was located at a very shallow depth of 3.1 miles. Shallow earthquakes are felt more strongly than deeper ones as they are closer to the surface. The exact magnitude, epicenter, and depth of the quake might be revised within the next few hours or minutes as seismologists review data and refine their calculations, or as other agencies issue their report.

Our monitoring service identified a second report from The Incorporated Research Institutions for Seismology (IRIS) which listed the quake at magnitude 5.3 as well.

It was the fourth-strongest earthquake in Texas history, the National Weather Service said.
