The Weather

High yesterday 53° The low this morning 53°
Yes, the above looks curious, but it's true.

Rainfall at the airport: This morning .02in. at 6:30am
Monday .01in., Sunday: 0in., Saturday: .24in.

Today: 90% chance of rain in Lampasas Co. today, but most of that will be coming to the eastern part of the county. A system is pushing up from the south today with morning fog and clouds that may, or may not, bring widespread rain to the county. The potential is there.

The day started off with lots of fog and a few scattered showers. That ends with a cloudy day and certain some rain in parts of the county, along with a high around 66°. The calm wind will turn south at about 5 mph.

Tonight: A 20% chance of rain early, then just clouds and eventually clearing with an overnight low of 45° and some west wind 5-10 mph.

Wednesday: Sunny, with a high near 71° and W-SW wind 5-10 mph. Overnight, it will drop to 49°.

Rest of the week: Thursday will bring 70-ish temps all day with a brisk S-SW wind gusting to 20 mph. It appears that rain chances come back in on Thursday night or Friday as a cold front arrives Friday that could keep the high down to 52° and a 40% chance of rain with it. That comes with N-NW winds up to 10 mph. It will likely be cold this weekend with low to mid-30s Saturday night and a high in the low 40s on Sunday, Christmas Eve.

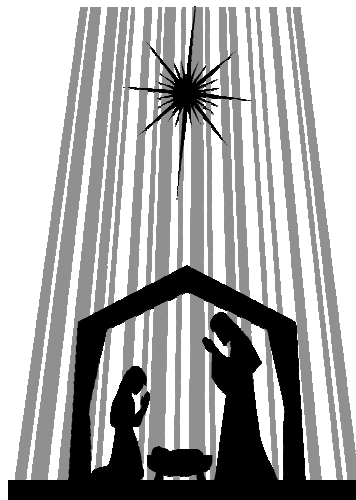
