Today: Sunshine comes back this morning and the high will rise to about 73° with W-SW wind 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Clear skies and a low dropping down to 46° with a light, 5 mph S-SW wind.

Thursday: Mostly sunny, with a high near 74° and S-SW wind 5-15 mph and a little gusty. Overnight, the rain chances come back with a 50% chance in our forecast.

Rest of the week: Friday will bring more rain chance, up to 80%, and with it will be falling temperatures. The high on Friday will be somewhere in the 50s in the morning, then the afternoon will be down to the upper 40s, dropping to the mid 30s for Friday's overnight.

The holiday weekend will start on Saturday with a dreary, cloudy and cool day with a high of 54° and light N-NW wind. Sunday, Christmas Eve, will be mostly sunny with a high only rising to 44°. When Santa comes in on Christmas Eve, he will have to be really wrapped up because it will easily be down to freezing by midnight and down to the mid-20s by early morning. On Christmas Day there will be a little sunshine coming back but it will be cold all day and the high will only be in the upper 40s.

Without our farmers, we wouldn't have many of our Christmas traditions.

Christmas trees. If you have a live tree, there's a good chance it came from a Texas Christmas tree farm.

Sugar. All those Christmas cookies and candy we look forward to with a childlike expectancy each year? Without sugar, they wouldn't be near as tasty. A large percentage of pure cane sugar is still grown and refined right here in Texas.

Wheat. Those homemade cinnamon rolls on Christmas morning and the tasty dinner rolls for dinner? They're made from wheat. Texas farmers grow hard and soft winter wheat—varieties used in yeast breads, rolls, cakes and pastries.

Beef, poultry, pork. Your holiday festivities aren't complete without a little protein. Texas is number one in cattle production so that beef might have been raised by a Texas rancher. But our farmers and ranchers also raise poultry and pork. Good chance that turkey or ham was raised here, even if it wasn't, its food might have been.

Cotton. From the soft flannel pajamas we wear to the blankets we snuggle under on Christmas Eve, cotton plays a large role. Even the coffee filter—so vital in our wake-up routines (*Cont. on back*)
