## The Weather

High yesterday was 56° Low this morning was 39°

The forecasters are calling for light rain chances this afternoon and tonight with Central Texas having the best chance of rainfall. The cloudy skies will hold temperatures in the 50's today and the mid 30's to lower 40's tonight. Sunday will begin a warming trend, with highs Monday in the mid and upper 60's.

**Today:** Cloudy with a high near 52°. Wind will be S-SE at 5-10 mph. There is a 40% chance of showers.

**Tonight:** Cloudy with a low near 34°. Winds will continue to be SE at 5 mph becoming W after midnight. There is a 30% chance of rain.

**Saturday:** There is a 20% chance of showers in the afternoon. Otherwise mostly sunny skies with a high near 57°. W-NW wind at 5-10 mph becoming N-NE in the afternoon.

**Saturday night:** N-NE wind at 5 mph becoming calm after midnight, with partly cloudy skies and a low of 32°.

**Sunday:** Sunny with a high temperature near 62°. Winds will be W-NW at 5 mph becoming calm in the afternoon.

**Overnight:** Clear and a low near 35°. Winds will be calm becoming SW near 5 mph after midnight



## Holiday Travel

The AAA is predicting a record breaking Holiday Travel Season this year.

AAA began tracking this information in 2000 and the 115.6 million slated to travel this season is the highest number on record. This year will see 4.3 million more people packing up and

heading out of town than last year.. And, ironically, delays are expected to be the worst on December 26<sup>th</sup>, with double the travel times expected. (Except New York and Washington DC, with 3 times the delays, but who would go there?)

According to INRIX, more than 104 million of these travelers will drive to their destinations. Air travel will see the largest increase with 6.97 million Americans expected to fly, the most since 2003.

Trains, buses & ships will see 3.81 million travelers.

AAA also stresses that, oh yeah, the holidays can be stressful. Maintain a cool head when traveling and focus on reaching your destination safely. Try not to offend other drivers, be tolerant and maintain space around your vehicle when driving. The price of gas has been steadily falling, and while prices may drop before New Years, gas may average a bit more than last year's \$2.37 per gallon. The average price for a gallon of gas is \$2.43, and the most common price across the country was \$2.39 a gallon. Texas does fall into the "5 cheapest states to buy gas", according to a 24/7 Wall Street study, at \$2.22 per gallon. The other 4 states were Missouri, Mississippi, Louisiana, and Oklahoma.

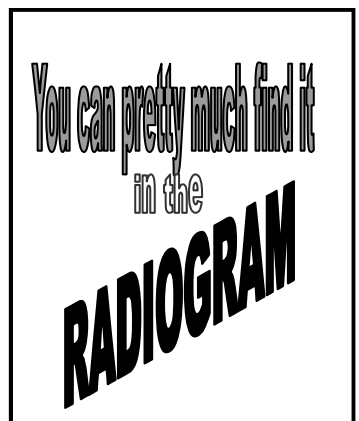

that we do so responsibly, including driving without distractions and obeying traffic laws as we travel during the Christmas and New Year's holidays," said DPS Director Steven McCraw. "DPS Troopers will increase their patrols, along with many other law enforcement partners across the state, throughout the remainder of the year. Troopers will be on the lookout for anyone violating the law and will remove dangerous drivers from our roadways — all in an effort to protect the public during the holidays." During the 2018 Christmas and New Year's holiday enforcement periods, DPS Troopers issued nearly 100,000 citations and warnings for a variety of violations, including speeding, no insurance and seat belt/child safety seat usage. In addition, DPS enforcement efforts resulted in 353 felony arrests, 348 fugitive arrests and 351 DWI arrests.

DPS offers the following tips to help drivers have a safe journey on our roadways during the holidays:

- Do not drink and drive. Make alternate travel plans if you are consuming alcohol.
- If you can *Steer It, Clear It*: If you are involved in a non-injury crash and your vehicle can be moved, clear the traffic lanes to minimize the impact on traffic. Leaving vehicles in a traffic lane not only increases traffic congestion, but it also leaves those involved with an increased risk of harm and chance for a secondary collision. On some highways, it is actually a violation of the law to not move your vehicle over when it is safe to do so.
- *Move Over or Slow Down* for police, fire, EMS, Texas Department of Transportation vehicles and tow trucks stopped on the side of the road with emergency lights activated. Also, show the same courtesy to fellow drivers stopped along the road.
- Slow down — especially in bad weather, construction areas, heavy traffic and unfamiliar areas.

- Eliminate distractions while driving, including the use of mobile devices. Texas law prohibits using a portable wireless device to read, write or send an electronic message unless the vehicle is stopped.
- Buckle up everyone in the vehicle — it's the law.
- Drive defensively, as holiday travel may present additional challenges.
- Don't drive fatigued — allow plenty of time to reach your destination.
- If you see a road hazard or if you observe anything suspicious, report it to the nearest law enforcement agency.
- On multi-lane roadways, use the left lane for passing only. Not only is it courteous driving and avoids impeding traffic, Texas law requires slower traffic to keep to the right and to only use the left lane for passing (when posted).

- Before your trip begins, make sure your vehicle is properly maintained and always double check to make sure all cargo is secure.

Monitor weather and road conditions wherever you are traveling. For road conditions/closings in Texas, visit [Drive Texas](#).

Police agencies, including the Texas Highway Patrol, will also increase enforcement efforts over the Christmas holiday as part of Operation CARE (Crash Awareness and Reduction Effort)!
