

The Weather



High yesterday was 72° The low this morning was 46°

Today: Unseasonably warm for one day (first official day of winter?), probably as high as 79°. S-SW wind will be 5-15 mph with increasing clouds as the day goes by.

Tonight: Around bedtime the rain chances will come in, and they'll get very likely by early morning, about 60% chance of rain overall. The temperature will drop down to about 55° by morning with the light south wind becoming N-NW at about 5-10 mph and bringing a cold front.

Friday: 80% chance of rain with the temperature dropping fast. It will drop to 45° by day's end, then continue dropping into the 30s overnight. The N-NW wind will be strong at 10-15 mph and gusting to 20. The rain may continue after dark Friday night. It does not appear that a freeze is likely.

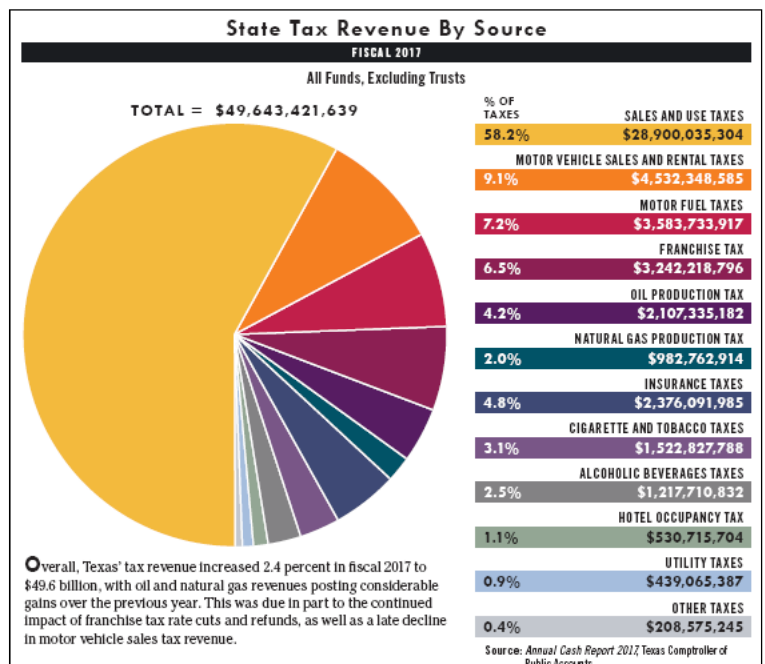
The weekend: The Saturday forecast shows mid-50s highs as the sun comes out with light NW wind. Saturday night will be in the 30s much of the time, but still not freezing, according to the long range forecast.

Sunday, Christmas Eve, should be cold, with a high of 52°, then when Santa shows up overnight it will be freezing. However, the long range view now shows that only being a light freeze, more like 30°. Christmas Day will be sunny with a high of 51° and light south wind. The overnight will be a little warmer at 36°.

People Ask

Multi-Agency Task Force Increases Enforcement during the Holidays

AUSTIN – Beginning Dec. 20 - 23 and Dec. 29 - Jan. 1, The Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS), Pflugerville Police Department and Round Rock Police Department will work together as The Lone Star High Initiative Task Force. The goal is to reduce burglaries, thefts, DWI enforcement and reckless driving through high visibility of police presence.

The Lone Star High Initiative Taskforce will respond to crime in and around shopping areas such as theft, burglary of vehicles and businesses. Officers will also be on the lookout for motorists who are violating traffic laws such as impaired driving or reckless driving behavior. DPS will provide additional support for partnering law enforcement agencies to assist with their ongoing traffic and crime-fighting initiatives, and the areas of patrol will include the use of marked and unmarked police (*Cont. on back*)

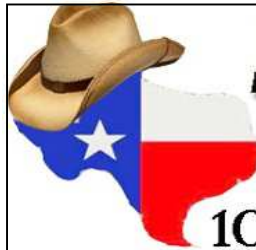


The Varsity is now 13-5 overall and 1-0 in district.
