The Weather



The High yesterday 62° The Low this morning 51°

Despite the cloud cover, expect another unseasonably warm day with low rain chances.

Tomorrow looks like a cloudy breezy day with unseasonably high temperatures again. Isolated storm and rain chances will increase from west to east paving the way for a pacific cold front. This will result in numerous showers. The front will move out toward the east on Saturday leaving behind much drier air and lows from the 30's to the 40's.

Today: cloudy with a high near 70°. Calm wind becoming SE in the morning.

Tonight: Cloudy with a low around 56° and SE wind about 5 mph.

Friday: Mostly cloudy, with a high near 71, and SE wind at 5-10 mph.

Friday Night: Mostly cloudy with a 50% chance of showers. A low of 53° and SE wind at 10-15 mph gusting to 20mph.

Saturday: Mostly cloudy with a 70% chance of showers. A high temperature near 69° and S wind at 10-15 mph becoming W-SW in the afternoon gusting to 20 mph.

Saturday Night: 41° with partly cloudy skies. W-SW wind at 5-10 mph. There is a 20% chance of showers before midnight.

Showbarn Preparation will take place starting at 9am Saturday January 4th, and all exhibitors are required to participate.

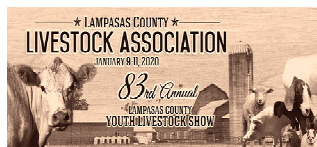
The first projects at the Stock Show will be the Ag Mechanics projects, and they must be in place and completed by 7pm Wednesday January 8th.

The Citizen Police Academy will begin January 2, 2020.

Classes are Free

Members of the department will cover a variety of topics that will highlight each departmental unit and its duties. The Academy will begin with an overview of the department and a tour of the facilities by Chief Bailey and Asst. Chief Cummings.

Instructors are sworn police officers, personnel of the department, and guest speakers with expertise in their field. Topics will include a State of the City by the City Manager Finley deGraffenried, patrol procedures, street survival, DWI enforcement, narcotics, criminal investigations, court procedures, family violence, animal control- animal shelter, code enforcement, mental health issues, and 911/communications. In addition, we will invite guest speakers to come join us and have additional classes to offer, all free of charge, to the participants of the program.
