place starting at 9am Saturday January 4<sup>th</sup>, and all exhibitors are required to participate.


The first projects at the Stock Show will be the Ag Mechanics projects, and they must be in place and completed by 7pm Wednesday January 8<sup>th</sup>.

Reside, own a business, or work in the City of Lampasas area. Willing to commit to 12 weeks of training Successfully complete a background investigation.


Applications will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on January 2,2020.


