## The Weather



The High yesterday 47° The Low this morning 35°

The 47° high above was at midnight Tuesday morning. It was down to 43° by noon and down to 41° by sunset.

The 35° low above was contrasted by 29° at San Saba, 32° at Lometa and 36° at Copperas Cove.

There was no measurable rainfall Tuesday at the airport but the fog left water dripping off many rooftops.

Today: Cloudy, with a high near 38°. N-NE wind will be 10-15 mph with gusts to 20 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy, with a low around 31° overnight and N-NE wind around 5 mph becoming calm.

Thursday: Mostly cloudy, with a high near 47° and no wind for a change. The overnight will be much the same but with a temperature drop to 36°.

Rest of the week: Friday will bring a little sunshine through the clouds, with a high near 55° and some gentle south wind. Friday night could bring drizzle by early morning along with low 40s. Saturday a 20% chance of rain that will hang around for the weekend. Sunday will see another cold front coming in with strong north winds.

## Stores Busy With Returns and Exchanges This Week

If you haven't already made your rounds of returns and exchanges, here are some things to remember:

Walmart in store returns are relatively easy if you have a receipt, but that's not always something that gets included with a Christmas gift, so what if??? Walmart's non-receipted returns policy is that you must present a valid government issued photo ID and go through their refund verification process. Your options then are to exchange the item, or to simply return it for a cash refund if the value was less than \$25. If the value is over \$25, they will issue you a shopping/gift card to be used at their store.

The above is for in-store only. Walmart says they are unable to exchange or provide refunds via mail.

What about Amazon furnished gifts? Get on your computer and go to their Online Returns Center. Enter the gift's order number, etc.

Since lots of items this year may have come from online purchases, you are going to have to lean on the purchaser/gift giver to help you out with some of this stuff.

For the in store purchased gifts, most stores will be happy to make exchanges for any merchandise in their store.

To avoid complications and difficult problems – do not put this off. Do your exchanges or refunds now, before the big sales mark stuff down or selections and sizes disappear.

## It's Good To Know Somebody's Watching – HEB Catches Contaminated Beef Stew Products.

On Christmas Eve, HEB grocery stores in San Antonio opened boxes of multi-vac packages of stew meat only to find them contaminated with pieces of plastic and metal. HEB pulled all the stew meat from its shelves in all stores and to be sure locked any sales out of its registers.

On Tuesday, the day after Christmas, about 4,702 pounds of stew meat was recalled from the Swift Beef-JBS USA plant in Cactus, TX because of the contamination.



The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service said the boneless stew items found with plastic and metal contamination by HEB on Dec. 24 were produced at Cactus on Dec. 13, 2017. Subject to the recall, according to FSIS, are:

Cases containing six 5-lb. bulk plastic bags containing fresh beef stew meat intended for HEB grocery store retailer re-package. The affected case code is 69404; re-packaged various beef stew meat trays that also contain vegetables. The meat trays are marked with establishment 7231, and there are several other beef stew meat packages that were recalled. If you recently purchases some beef stew meat from HEB, check it out.
