The Weather



High yesterday was 64° Low this morning was 52°

In spite of the cloudiness this afternoon, occasional sunshine combined with the southerly winds should have high temperatures topping out between 65° and 75°. Tomorrow will see a pacific front making its way through Central Texas, but forecasters are saying that we will have cloudy skies and spotty rain, but any storms will be closer to I35.

Today: Cloudy with a high near 71° after the fog burns off. Wind will be SE at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Cloudy with a low near 60° and patchy drizzle before midnight, then a chance of showers after 3am. Winds will be S-SE at 10-15 mph. There is a 50% chance of rain.

Saturday: Showers and a possible storm before noon, then a chance of showers continues. A high near 69°. S-SW wind at 10-15 mph becoming W-SW in the afternoon gusting to 20 mph. There is an 80% chance of rain.

Saturday night: W wind at 5-10 mph. Partly cloudy skies and a low near 42°.

Sunday: Sunny with a high temperature near 62°. Winds will be W-NW at 10-15 mph increasing to 20-25 mph in the morning, gusting to 30 mph.

Overnight: Clear and a low near 29°. Winds will be W at 5-10 mph.

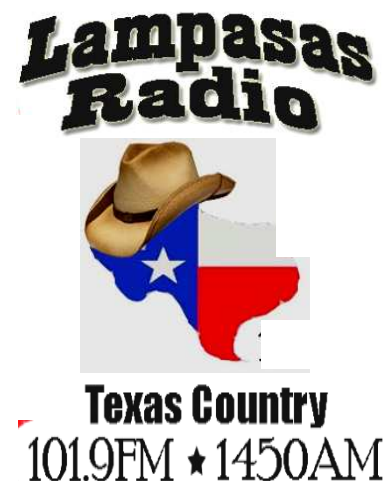
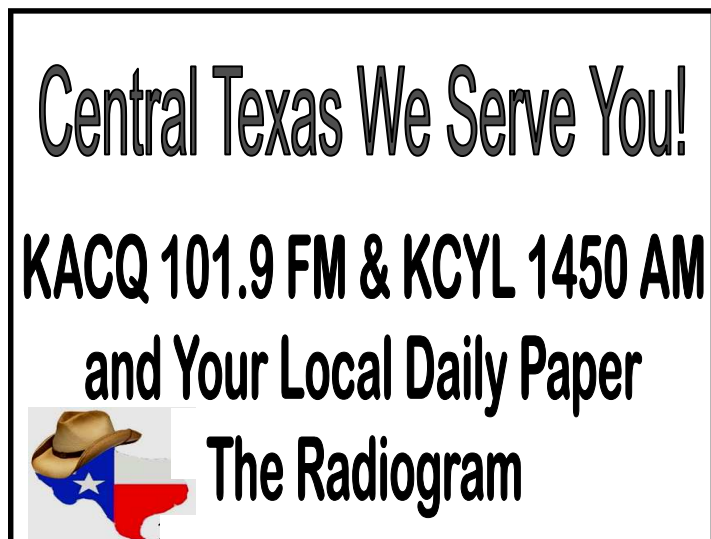
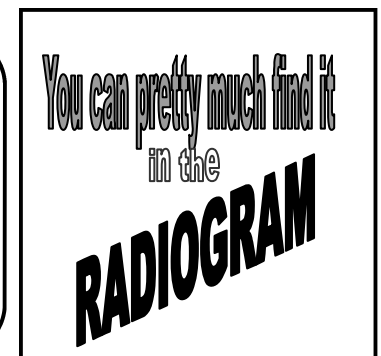

Fireworks Ban

Lampasas County Judge Randall Hoyer

signed an order restricting certain fireworks in unincorporated areas of Lampasas County. Lampasas County is experiencing extremely dry conditions, enhancing a normal fire danger.

The Order states that "a person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as "skyrockets with sticks" or missiles with fins in any portion of the unincorporated areas of Lampasas County.

The order also states that it does not prohibit "permissible fireworks". Violation of this order will be a class C misdemeanor.
