The Weather



The high yesterday was 54° (Just before midnight)
The low this morning was 51° (at 5am)

Today: A chance of drizzle with patchy fog before noon, otherwise cloudy with a high near 51° and N-NW wind around 5-10 mph.

Tonight: A chance of drizzle, cloudy, with a low around 34° and NE wind 5-10 mph.

Sunday: A slight chance of drizzle, probably early, as the arctic cold front comes in. Cloudy with a high near 38°, NE wind 10-15 mph with gusts to 20 mph as the most severe cold front of the season so far comes in.

New Year's Eve will be bitter cold, down to 21° and wind chills likely to hit 10° because of a 15-20 mph north wind. There could be possible ice on the ground if there was much drizzle on Sunday. Right now it does not seem very likely that the drizzle will continue into Sunday afternoon so most of that effect should be gone by dark. There is currently no outlook for snow or sleet.

The freezing temperatures will likely come before midnight and continue downward from there.

New Year's Day will probably not get above the upper 20s all day, then drop into the teens Monday night.

Tuesday will be more of the same, not coming above the freezing point during the day and back into the teens overnight. The letup should come Wednesday when we see mid-40s for a while, but it will not likely be out of the 20s in the overnight all week.

That's the forecast for now – cold!

Arctic Cold Front for New Years



Arctic Cold Front – the very sound of it is scary, especially if you live in an older home with exposed water pipes, or if you have outside pets or if you're a rancher with livestock on open prairie. As you can see in our weather forecasts, starting on Sunday, we are going to have an arctic cold front in our area with temperatures dropping to the 20s, possibly even into the teens.

It brings up visions of shivering animals needing hay, or shivering ranchers taking care of them. To the workers with unfinished jobs that have to be finished before freezing temperatures arrive, there are

visions of cold wind down their collars and frozen fingers that have to keep moving.

Offhand, we have a hard time figuring out who could possibly like cold weather. Especially, we think, when it is occurring at a time when we all want to celebrate the arrival of the New Year.
