The Weather



The High yesterday 58° The Low this morning 35°

After a cold start this morning, temperatures will warm quickly in the 50's by afternoon. Look for NW winds of 10-15 mph gusting to 20mph today, gradually decreasing into the evening and nighttime hours. Most of the area should see temperatures in the mid 20's and low 30's tonight.

New Year's Eve night shouldn't be quite as cold as tonight.

Temperatures are slated to fall into the upper 30's and low 40's by midnight. High temperatures on Wednesday will be in the 50's with rain chances on the rise in the Central Texas area.

Today: Sunny with a high near 56°. Winds will be from the NW at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Wind will be N at 5 mph becoming calm. Skies will be clear with a low near 31°.

New Year's Eve: Sunny and 58°. Winds will be calm becoming N-NE near 5 mph in the afternoon.

New Year's Eve Night: Winds will be E at 5 mph becoming calm in the evening. Skies will be mostly cloudy with a low near 36°.

New Year's Day: : Mostly cloudy with a high near 58°. Winds will be S-S at 5-10 mph. There is a 30% chance of showers in the morning hours.

New Year's Night: Mostly cloudy skies with a low near 43°, and S wind near 10 mph.

Thursday looks like a pretty day with partly sunny skies and a high near 70°. A 20% chance of showers and SW wind at 10-20 mph gusting to 25 mph.

New Laws Effective January 1

There are 24 laws that become effective on January 1st 2020. Many will change things for Texans. Some of the included changes are:

Senate Bill 212 will require reporting of incidents of Sexual harassment, sexual assault, dating violence or stalking by an employee of a public, private or independent institution of higher learning. This will be a class B misdemeanor offense if the employee fails to do so.

HB 4390 relates to the privacy of personal information and the creation of the Texas Privacy Protection Advisory Council. It amends the Texas Business and Commerce Code and says a person who conducts business in Texas and has computerized data that includes sensitive personal information shall disclose any breach of the system's security to any individual whose sensitive information was or is thought to have been acquired by an unauthorized person. Notification of a data breach must be made within 60 days of when the business learned that the breach occurred. The business must also notify the Texas Attorney General of the breach within 60 days of learning of the breach if it involves at least 250 Texas residents.

SB 7 moves \$1.7 billion from the states rainy day fund to the Texas Water Code, which established two new accounts: The Flood Infrastructure Fund AND the Texas Infrastructure Resiliency Fund. It allows the Texas Water Development Board to issue revenue bonds for both new accounts and it prioritizes financial assistance for counties where the median household income is less than 85% of the state's median household income. 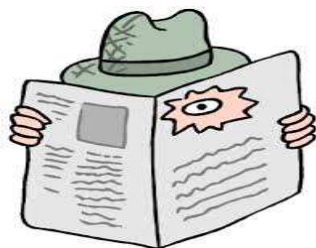
