Statewide, according to the DSHS, there were 11,928 new and 2358 probable new cases on December 29th, along with 71 deaths. There were also 4,917 Texans in the hospital with Covid-19. Locally, the DSHS dashboard for cases shows 2 new confirmed cases in Lampasas County on December 29th, and 34 confirmed cases in the last 14 days. The state estimates Lampasas County to have 51 active cases at this time.
