The Weather

Look for the New Year to begin on a chilly note with highs in the upper 40's to mid 50's, and rain and clouds will not allow the temperatures to warm much. The forecasters say to look for rain to increase and spread across Central Texas through tomorrow afternoon.

Gusty winds are expected Thursday night as a cold front arrives making for a colder Friday morning. The winds continue through the day on Friday and are expected to continue Friday night under clearing skies. Wind chill values Saturday morning are expected to be in the 20's.

Today: Sunny with a high near 57° and calm wind becoming E near 5 mph in the afternoon.

New Year's Eve: A low near 37° with increasing clouds. E-SE wind at 5 mph becoming calm.

New Year's Day: Cloudy with a high near 52° and a 50% chance of showers. Wind will be S near 5-10 mph.

Wednesday Night: A 70% chance of showers in the evening, with a low near 45°. Wind will be S near 10 mph.

Thursday: Partly sunny with a high near 66° and a 20% chance of showers. Wind will be W-SW at 10-15 mph gusting to 25 mph.

Thursday Night: Mostly clear with a low near 40°. W-SW wind at 10 mph.

Friday: Sunny with a high near 59°. NW wind at 10-20 mph gusting to 30 mph

Deputies Investigate Explosives



Lampasas Radio learned from the Lampasas County Sheriff's Department that "On 12/29/2019 the Lampasas county Sheriff's Office responded to an address located on South River Road in Lampasas County in reference to suspicious circumstances. Upon further investigation a quantity of live antique blasting caps and a small quantity of explosive materials were located. The caps and explosives had manufacture dates over 20 years old and were possible unstable. US Army EOD (explosives ordnance

disposal) from Ft. Hood, Texas was dispatched to the location. EOD personnel rendered the explosives safe and transported all blasting caps and explosive materials back to Ft. Hood for disposal. At this point there is not criminal act suspected and no criminal investigation is warranted. We were glad to have been notified by the land owner for a safe immediate removal and disposal"

Holiday Closings



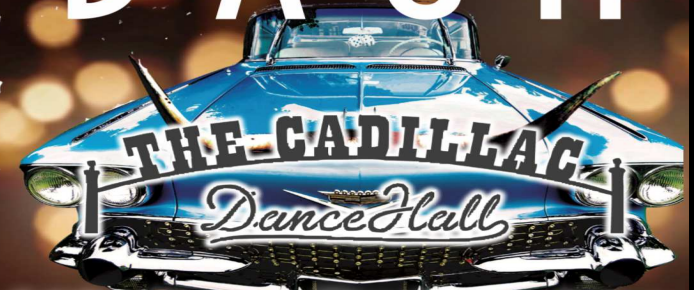

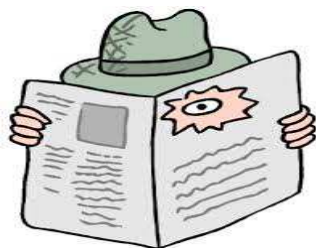
