The Weather



The High yesterday was 73° The Low this morning 65°

Today: Mostly cloudy with a high near 79°. The rain chances have gone out of the forecast for the day, holding off for tonight. The S-SW wind will be 10-15 and a little gusty ahead of the cold front coming in tonight.

Tonight: A 40% chance of rain and there will be a big wind shift with a N-NW wind arriving with a strong cold front, getting up to 15-20 mph and gusting to 25. The overnight low will be about 48°.

Tuesday: The rain chances go way down for Tuesday, to 20%, but the cold hangs around, only getting up to 52° at the high, and worse yet, the N-NE wind will blow 15-20 mph and gust to perhaps 25 mph. That continues overnight as the low drops to 39° in the hill country.

Rest of the week: The rain chances are only 20% through Wednesday afternoon, but come back Wednesday night at 40%, along with a 38° low. The north wind gets lighter for the rest of the week but the cold hangs around. Thursday night will be down to 34° and Friday night down to 38°. The highs all week, after Monday, will be in the 50s.

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. Saturday blotter report shows suspicious vehicle reports at 1700 CTC at midnight and 200 block of N. Key at 2:48am, fraud at 8:50am in the 1300 block of W. Ave B.
