The Weather



High yesterday was 55° The low this morning was 38° The forecast just keep getting worse!

Today: Rain, sleet and snow expected, with a high near 38° and N-NE wind 5-10 mph. Precipitation chances 90%.

Tonight: The rain, sleet and snow chances continue overnight, with a low around 39°, The N-NW wind will be light at 5-10 mph. Precipitation chances 50%.

Thursday: Still a slight chance of rain but a little warmer with a high near 47°. The wind will get up to 10-15 mph and coming out of the north with gusts to 20 mph. Thursday night is expected to be the coldest yet with a freeze coming, down to 29° overnight.

Rest of the week: The warmup, to some degree anyway, comes on Friday. It will be up to about 55° with a W-NW wind 5-15 mph. It will continue to warm up a little with highs in the mid 60s over the weekend, and the overnight lows will be in the mid to upper 30s. That appears to be the same weather we'll have early next week.

Texans are urged to stay informed about changing weather in their area and to take steps now to help stay safe during the coming months.”

Texans should winterize their vehicles by checking the battery, windshield wipers (including appropriate freeze resistant-fluid), tire pressure, tire tread, fluid levels, and lubricate door and trunk locks to prevent freezing. In addition, keep emergency supplies in the vehicle and:

The girls will go on Friday only. Both teams will compete with Killeen Ellison.



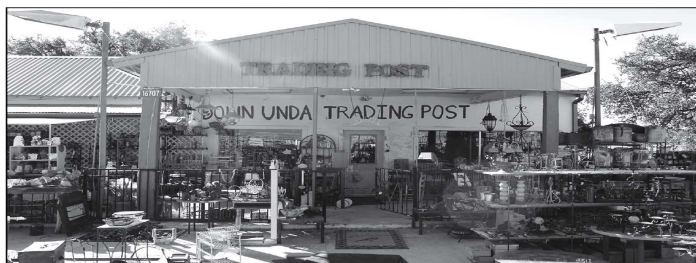
