The Weather



High yesterday was 48°. It only lasted about 5 minutes, then went back to the low 40s norm for the day.

The Low this morning was 23°.

Today: Sunny with a high near 52° as the wind shifts back to W-NW at 5-10 mph.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low around 33° and W-NW wind 5 mph.

Saturday: Sunny with a high near 60° but the wind shifts back to N-NW and brisk at 10-15 and gusting to 25 mph with a new cold front. Overnight the temperature should be dropping again, down to 31° with NW wind calming again at 5 mph.

The rest of the weekend and next week: Sunday will be a pretty nice day at 65° for the high, with the wind giving up its northerly push and going back around to W-SW. This signals the end of this cold front – for a day. But, get ready for another one.

A weak cold front will push in late Monday and drop the overnight temperature down into the upper 30s. Through at least the middle of next week we'll see upper 30s and low 40s overnights and daytime highs in the 60s.

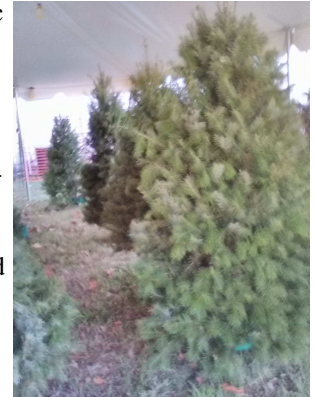

The Blotter



Lampasas Police Dept. blotter for Thursday showed a suspicious vehicle in the 100 block of E. 9th at 7:32am, otherwise it was a quiet morning.

The afternoon saw an accident in the 800 block of S. Key at 3:41pm involving two vehicles and no serious injury. At 4:32pm there was suspicious activity in the 400 block of E. 7th.

In the evening a reckless driver report came from the 2000 block of CTE. A theft was reported in the 100 block of W. North Ave. at 9:38pm and at 9:57pm there was a domestic disturbance report on Hollywood Drive.

Lampasas Sheriff's Dept. blotter shows Lometa with an animal problem but pretty quiet. Kempner had some animal problems, along with a medical call. There were two crashes in Copperas Cove as well as a disturbance and a civil matter, and out in the county there was a crash, several traffic stops, a civil matter, a suicidal person, illegal dumping and an animal problem.

The jail log showed the arrest of a 37 yr old Lampasas man on a probation violation, a 43 yr old Lometa man on a probation violation, and a 48 yr old man on a bench warrant.

The Burn Ban in Lampasas Co. is lifted thru Sunday. Note: This is not official but, it appears that there are few times between now and the weekend that would be good for outside burning. They would possibly be mid to late afternoon today, or on Sunday. Those times should be less windy. The burn ban goes back into effect at 6pm Sunday afternoon and dryer weather is expected next week.

Lady Badger Varsity Basketball will be at home against Austin Savio. The JV will also be playing Savio here. They'll be at the Competition Gym with a 5:30pm rolling start. (This is a change.)

Middle School Basketball, both boys and girls, played Burnet on Thursday with the Boys on the road.

The 8th grade Boys B team beat Burnet 42-19 at Burnet. The effort saw 4 boys scoring 6 points each, Jovon Barnes, Conner Keele, Frank Holland and Cooper Greiner. Close behind was Carson Bekker with 5.

The M.S. Girls were at home with the 7th B losing to Burnet 14-19. Coach Wiley said they were down by 2 at the half but in the 3rd period their point guard fouled out and after that they fell behind more. Top scorers were Madison Roedler with 12 and Courtney Allen with 2.
