The Weather

The High yesterday 69° The Low this morning 46°

Today: Partly sunny with a high near 75° and S-SW wind 10-20 mph with gusts as high as 30 mph.

Tonight: Overnight a small rain chance comes in with a low around 60° and the wind again out of the S-SW around 15 mph and gusty.

Friday: Cloudy skies at first turn sunny later and it gets very warm with a high near 87°. The W-SW wind will cool it off a little with 10-15 mph and gusty effects.

The Weekend: That rain chance comes back with a 30% shot at it on Saturday, mainly in the morning. After that the afternoon high goes up to about 84°. The wind will be southerly and about 5-10 mph. On Sunday there will be a 20% chance of rain and a high of about 85°.

City Trash Collection Station Opened on Wednesday

Better options now available for disposing of "stuff"

Lampasas Citizen's Collection Station is now open Wednesday thru Friday from 10am to 3pm at the City's Yard at 201 Brown St..

This is a place where you can haul a pickup or trailer full of "stuff" for disposal. The question is "What 'stuff' can you take and what's the difference between taking it there yourself, and allowing the trash contractor to pick it up at your house?"

The answers: The "stuff" in this case is construction debris, grass clippings and leaves, old appliances, batteries, scrap metal, old tires, etc. In general, it is things that the regular trash collection service won't pick up. That is the big reason why we will all enjoy this new City service. Another reason is that you can do your garage cleanup, etc., and know that you can load it all up in your pickup or trailer and get rid of it – on your schedule.

The new service is not free, but if you are a resident of Lampasas and have a copy of a utility bill with you, it is pretty reasonable.



You can haul in a load of sheetrock, etc. for about \$20, an old appliance will cost you \$1, and the average tire will cost you \$5. And, the City is giving everybody a free trip to the collection station (no fees) until April 4th.

So, it's a good time to clean out the garage!

Oh yeah... They will not accept TVs or electronics, nor pesticides, nor dead animals or appliances that contain Freon, and not your regular household garbage (We asked what that last one meant and were told it meant "putrifiable" stuff).

Food Handlers Training



A multi-county Food Handlers course, accredited by the Texas Dept. of State Health Services is being offered by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service, the Burnet & Lampasas County Extension Family & Community Health Agents.

New "Texas Food Establishment Rules" (TFER) require all food service employees to complete an accredited food handlers training program within 60 days of employment. This 2 hour course is now required for all food service employees. The certificate is good for 2 years and valid anywhere in the state of Texas.

To register for the course call the Lampasas Extension Office at 512-556-8271. Registration can also be done in person. The cost is \$20 and must be paid in full before the course begins.
