The Weather

Yesterday's high was 60° This morning's low 40° Rainfall Thursday at the airport .39 in.

Today: Mostly sunny today with a high near 67° and a N-NE wind 5-10 mph becoming SE.

Tonight: Partly cloudy with a low around 50° and E-SE wind around 5 mph early becoming calm.

Saturday: Increasing clouds, with a high near 68° and SE wind between 5 and 10 mph. Overnight the rain chances appear about 40% with a low of 57° and S-SE wind that will be typically 10 mph.

The rest of the weekend: Sunday the chances of rain hang around, especially in the morning, and the south wind will be brisk at 10-15 mph and gusting to 25. High temperature should be in the upper 50s. Sunday night the wind begins to shift from south back to west and then N-NW by Monday at 5-10 mph.

Early Voting Down to the Last Day – Last Chance



Another 201 voters came in to cast ballots at the Elections Office on Thursday, and the mail had seen another 15 ballots by mail delivered to the office.

That brings the total Early Vote to 1810 with this last day expected to bring in another 200 or more ballots.

You can cast your ballot today until 5pm today at the Elections Office at 407 S. Pecan on Courtyard Square, downtown. You must have your Voter Registration Card and your photo ID. If you don't have a photo ID such as a Texas Driver License, you could have a Texas Election ID issued by the DPS or a Texas personal ID issued by the DPS, a Texas Handgun License issued by the DPS, a US Military ID card with a photo, a US Citizenship Certificate with a photo or a US Passport book or card. If you don't have any of the above...there is a special form you can fill out along with other suitable and convincing ID. There is little excuse for not voting if you are a registered voter.

If you do not have transportation to the polling place, you can call the radio station at 512-556-6193 and we will help you with a ride to

On Saturday they'll be back at Gatesville with a noon game against Bosqueville and a 3:45pm game against Moody.


After that, it's back to the home game schedule with their <u>first district</u> game on Tuesday against Taylor at 7pm.
