The Weather

The High yesterday 85°

The Low this morning 67°

Today: 60% chance of rain and we are hoping for a good one. Cloudy skies are the norm today with a high near 75° and S-SE wind around 10 mph.

Tonight: 90% chance of rain, with a fairly light 5-10 mph wind coming out of the east. The low will be about 59°.

Wednesday: 70% chance of rain with a high temperature of only 69° as the N-NW wind comes in light but with a nice coolness.

By nightfall the rain chances will begin to disappear and the temperature will drop to about 51° by morning.

The rest of the week: Thursday will bring sunshine again but with a NE light breeze the temperature will stay in the mid to upper 70s. Pretty much the same forecast is with us on Friday as we top out in the mid 70s.

Saturday, the Diamondback Jubilee Festival will have its problems with some strong wind out of the S-SW that will be hard on tent shelters. The gusts could get as high as 30 mph. The temperature will be moderate at about 80 or 81° at the afternoon high point. Easter Sunday should be a very nice day with a mid to upper 70s high at around 3 or 4pm.

Commissioners Meet

The Lampasas County Commission met on Monday morning and dealt with a relatively light agenda.

The one agenda item involving funding was a request for a contract approval of \$438,860, for the ATMOS gas line to the new jail and sheriff's office. This would involve replacing approximately 2,400 feet of existing 2" line with 4" line and then extending the line a total of 3,800 feet to reach the jail site.

Commissioner Carroll raised the question of, why should the County pay for



upgrading the existing ATMOS infrastructure? The original cost estimate was \$70,000. It was agreed that more information was needed, and the architect for the project, Kenny Burns, would need to look at it.

A presentation on the Texas 4000 for Cancer, Austin to Anchorage bike ride was made by Joe Corcoran for the Lampasas stage on June 2nd. There are 25-mile and 50-mile ride options.

Also, during this portion of the meeting, Commissioner Carroll introduced Ronnie Goodwin to the Court. Mr. Goodwin has been appointed as the in-house construction supt. for the jail project.

City Council Meets

The Lampasas City Council met Monday evening in a Special Session that immediately adjourned for an Executive Session. A half hour later they reconvened for the Workshop session. Two items took the bulk of attention in the Workshop.

The first item, for discussion only, was a look at the Development Agreement for the Stone Valley Subdivision. Assistant City Manager, Gary Cox, reported that a preliminary estimate for electrical development stood at \$72,000. A more costly estimate for Public Improvements was also examined. This included site work for drainage for the subdivision, runoff from 580, and retention dams, up to 12' high. Plans will be submitted for insurance analysis for impact on risk pools. Initial estimate for this work came in at \$850,000.

Requirements regarding the structure of City appointed boards came up for discussion, where there is a continuing shortage of qualified volunteers to fill board member positions. Discussion revolved around how to adjust qualifications requirements to open positions to a greater pool of volunteers. Mayor Misti Talbert proposed that the board positions should be open to anyone living in Lampasas County, even though they may not live within the City of Lampasas. It was questioned whether there should be a property ownership requirement within the City. It was agreed (*cont.on back*)
