The Weather

The High yesterday 62° The Low this morning 40°
Rainfall at the airport Wednesday was .03 in. but it rained again early this morning about 2am, some .39 in.

Today: Partly sunny and warmer with a high near 68° with calm wind shifting to S-SE between 10 and 15 mph.

Tonight: Increasing clouds, with a low around 52° and south wind 10-15 mph.

Friday: A 20% chance of rain after noon, otherwise cloudy with a high near 71° and south wind 10-15 mph with gusts up to 25 mph. Overnight it will be mostly cloudy with south wind 10-15.

The Weekend: Saturday will be warm and nice, up to 87° with sunshine, but slightly marred by strong south winds that herald one more brief cool front. The south winds will shift to west and on around to north overnight. That will bring a big temperature drop on Sunday, down to a high of about 65. The north wind will be strong all day Sunday and into the night, bringing a cool Monday and into mid-week.

How's Business? Sales Tax Reports

The monthly sales tax report that reflects taxes collected in Lampasas County retail businesses in January is in. The Cities in the County get checks from the State that amount to their part of the sales tax that was collected in January here, sent to the State in February, and then the City's part returned to it in March.

It shows the City of Lampasas got a check for \$136,178 this time, some 7.6% better than the same month's check last year of \$126,550. So, business would appear to have grown by 7.6% in Lampasas.

Kempner's check was for \$8,044, down some 32.57% from last year at the same time. This kind of change is usually brought on by some irregularity in filing by a quarterly business filer or two.

Lometa got a check for \$7,198, a whopping 27.47% higher than the same check last year. Again, this kind of check reflects the irregularities often seen in small communities where there are quarterly filers.

For a different comparison we look at neighboring Burnet where the check was for \$155,549, an increase of 1.16% over the last year.

San Saba got \$52,566, way up by 41% over last year. San Saba has had a lot of increases over the past year.

Copperas Cove got a big check for \$337,790. That was up 7.78% over last year.
