The Weather

The High yesterday 81° This morning's low 43°
Rainfall on Tuesday was .32 in, at the airport.



The rainfall champ was at an LCRA gauge W-SW of Lampasas that registered .85 in. and it hailed dime-size pellets in many spots west of Lampasas on Tuesday.

Today: Sunny, with a high near 65° with NE wind between 10 and 15 mph and gusting.

Tonight: Mostly clear with a low around 45° and the light SE wind will be 5-10 mph.

Thursday: Mostly sunny, with a high near 77° and calm wind becoming south at 10-15 mph and gusting to 20. Overnight it will be warmer than the night before with a low down to about 63° and with a lot of south wind.

Rest of the week: Friday will be cloudy and with a 20% chance of rain. That will increase Friday night. Saturday, mostly cloudy with a high near 58° and with a chilling N-NE wind that could gust to 25 mph. Sunday will warm up again, with a high around 79° and south win 5-15 mph.

Lometa ISD Putting Guns in Hands of School Staff



Lometa School Superintendent David Fisher is quick to explain the "why" of the plan to arm certain staff members with concealed weapons. "We're protecting our students," he says, and he goes on to explain that Lometa is a rural school, 15-20 miles away from any sizable town, with little quick access to a lot of law enforcement.

The plan to allow concealed carry by staff has actually been in effect for a few years now, he says, but he had stopped it when he took over the Superintendent position. He wanted to make sure the plan was carried out properly. So-o, on March 23rd, the school board had voted unanimously on a volunteer list of 10 staff members who would be allowed to carry concealed guns on campus.

The next step is to have those 10 get their concealed carry permits, then undertake additional "situation" training. Principal Jamie Smart is charged with directing the special situation training. When asked just when these volunteers would actually begin carrying concealed weapons, Fisher wouldn't say. He said it might be next week and might be many weeks, but it would be as soon as possible.

What's Happening?



It's Sale Day at Lampasas Cattle Auction

The sale will begin at 12:30pm today at the sale barn north of town. Last week the prices were steady to stronger on a very limited test of 125 head, due to rainfall in the area. A larger run is expected today. Last week 500-600lb steers were bringing \$1.45 to \$1.61/lb and some young to mid-age cow/calf pairs fetched \$1,400 to \$1,500/pair.

State Sales Tax Revenue Well Up From Last Year



Texas Comptroller Glenn Hegar said on Tuesday that Texas sales tax revenue totaled \$2.4 billion in March, 7.2 percent more than in March 2017.

"Sales tax revenue rose for almost all major economic sectors, indicating growth in both business and consumer spending," Hegar said. "Receipts from the oil and gas mining, construction and manufacturing sectors, as well as retail trade and restaurants, were up, while receipts from the information sector were slightly down from a year ago."

In looking at overall Texas tax income for the period, we can see that the huge increase in oil and gas well production (much of it from "fracking" operations) saw an increase of over 38% as compared to last year. Other notes show that auto sales were down

Texas Housing Expensive?

In another data report from the Comptroller's Office we find that Texas Housing Prices are not only on the rise, they are rising faster than the state's personal income.

"For years, Texas has built a reputation as a place where families can live well for less, with several of its metropolitan areas consistently ranked among the nation's most affordable. The economic success of our cities is changing that picture, however, and according to the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, the rise in Texas home prices has outpaced that of the nation as a whole since 2011. Similarly, a recent Texas A&M Real Estate Center study indicates that Texas housing prices have been rising faster than the state's personal income. These rapid price increases aren't occurring uniformly throughout the state, of course, but in all they may reduce Texas' traditional cost of living advantage.

The Badger Varsity baseball team lost a 6 run lead in the bottom of the 5th inning as the state 4A, 12th ranked Salado Eagles scored 5 runs to cut the lead to 1. Then in the bottom of the 6th the Eagles added two runs to take the lead and win 7-6.

The Badgers got on the board in the first inning when Hunter Rebando hit a triple, driving in 2 runs. Then Haydn Hammerschmidt drove a long fly ball over the left field fence scoring 3 runs and giving the visiting Badgers a 5-0 lead. In the 4th inning the Badgers would add another score when Austin Hilgenberg would score from 3rd base on a passed ball to make it a 6-0 ballgame. Some reflection here, "The Badgers scored 6 runs on a team who had won all 5 district games they had played, and in all those games, only one run had been scored against them. Back to the game sequence, Lampasas 6-0 lead would hold until the bottom of the 5th, due to excellent pitching by Marty Ybarra and fielding by the Badgers. But, that was about to change when the Eagles came out in the 5th and collected on some big hits, helped by a few costly Badger errors. Suddenly, the Badger lead was cut to 6-5.

The Badger bats went cold in the top of the 6th and when the Eagles came to bat Ace Whitehead relieved Ybarra on the mound. Salado led off with two singles, a strikeout, then a walk to load the bases. Eagle's 3rd baseman Rustin Hale hit a single to left field scoring the tying run.
