We get closer to the end-of-year at Lampasas ISD. We'll have Dr. Chane Rascoe in our studio Tuesday morning in the 8am hour to discuss Lampasas schools, what's happening now, graduation and what's in our future.

Thursday: The LHS Band will have an Awards Ceremony in the Cafeteria at 6:30pm on Thursday.

The event here will take place at the Hanna Springs Sculpture Garden at Campbell Park from 8am to 5pm

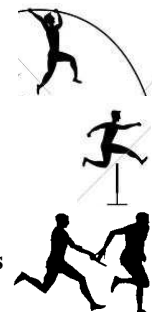

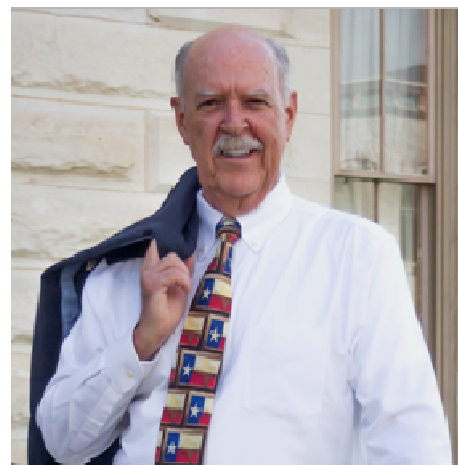
