The Weather

Next Week will be busy, starting with the County Commissioners meeting at 9am on Monday morning. They'll have some discussion on rabies control, hiring additional Deputies at the Sheriff's Department, Road and Bridge equipment and the Jail Project.

Lampasas City Council meets at 5:30pm in workshop, then a regular session at 7pm. Some of the workshop session will include a rehash of last Monday's Town Hall on parks and recreation, some on the budget preparation and some on a recycling program. One of the matters in regular session will be selection of a contractor in the Old City Hall remodel project. They will also canvass votes from the City Council Election and seat the new Council Member, Cathy Kuehne. They will also select a new Mayor Pro Tem for the year.

Matters in regular session will also include a possible action on a request for a specific use permit for property at 512 e. Ave. J to allow for a food processing plant. Other discussion will include the Chamber of Commerce financials and agreements on activities.

We get closer to the end-of-year at Lampasas ISD. We'll have Dr. Chane Rascoe in our studio Tuesday morning in the 8am hour to discuss Lampasas schools, what's happening now, graduation and what's in our future.
