The Weather



The High yesterday 89° This morning's low 65°
Rainfall started about 5:15pm at the Lampasas airport. By midnight it had rained .27 inches.

Today: A 40% chance of rain, possibly a thunderstorm, this afternoon. Before that kind of weather comes, it will be mostly sunny with a high near 92° and a west wind that will be between 5 and 10 mph before turning calm.

Tonight: The rain chances are still set at about 40% prior to midnight, otherwise it will be partly cloudy with a low around 67° and east wind 5-10 mph becoming S-SW.

Thursday: Mostly sunny with a high near 95° and south wind about 5-10 mph.

Overnight it will get down to about 69° and the wind will be out of the south around 10 mph.

Rest of the week: Friday will bring mostly sunshine with a high near 92° and a good bit of wind out of the south.

Saturday and Sunday will be in the area of 90° at the afternoon high point. Saturday will be very windy with south wind about 15 mph and gusting to 25. Sunday will have a wind shift to S-SE and it will be about 10 mph.
