Fatal Crash

A fatal crash was reported on US 183 about 4.5 miles south of Austin on Monday that claimed the life of 21 year old Victor Aguirre-Arroyo,

who died at the scene.

The vehicle was traveling southbound on 183 at a high rate of speed.

According to an eye witness there was a motorcycle traveling northbound in the left lane. The driver of the vehicle thought the motorcycle was coming into his lane head on.

The driver then made a hard left turn at a high rate of speed right in front of the motorcycle. The maneuver caused the vehicle to go into the right hand side and skid across onto incoming lanes of traffic and into the northbound grass shoulder. The vehicle began to overturn, ejecting the driver.

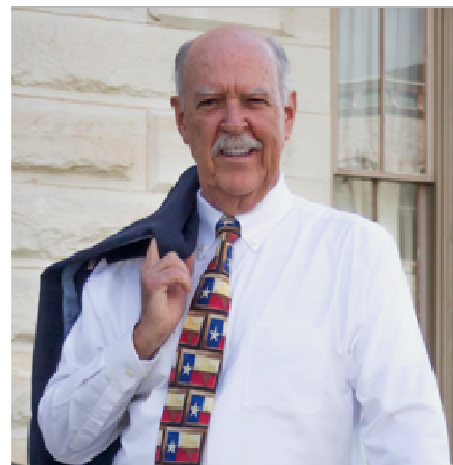
This program will be available starting May 29th going through July 24th at the Hanna Springs Cafeteria. There is no paperwork required to participate.
