The Texas Department of Transportation says that their annual Click It Or Ticket is going to be enforced strongly from May 21st to June 3rd.



They say that seat belt use has increased to nearly 92% in the state, yet 929 people were killed when not wearing seat belts last year. 57% of those crashes occurred at night. The Brownwood District of TxDOT saw 30 traffic crashes in 2017 where there were unrestrained occupants and fatal or serious injuries.

Buckling up is the single most effective step drivers and passengers can take to protect themselves in a crash. It will reduce the risk of dying in a crash by 45% in a car and by 60% in a pickup truck.

Multi Agency Fraud Investigation
